Dear Miss Busselle:

I have received your communication of February 27th, together with the letter from Rose LaChapelle of Manistique, Michigan, which she addressed to Senator Kennedy, the letter she received from "Life" magazine, and her self-addressed, stamped envelope.

In response to her comments, the FBI, at the direction of President Johnson, conducted a prompt, intensive, objective and thorough investigation of the assassination of President Kennedy. The results of this investigation were accurately reported to the Warren Commission, and not one shred of evidence has been developed to link any other person in a conspiracy with Lee Harvey Oswald to assassinate President Kennedy. All available evidence and facts point to one conclusion—that Oswald acted alone in his crime.
