"THE PROPER FORUM FOR DETERMINATION OF THE LEGAL QUES-TIONS OF WHETHER A CHANGE OF VENUE SHOULD OR SHOULD NOT BE GRANTED IS IN OPEN COURT, AND NOWHERE ELSE."

THE ARTICLE REPORTED THAT THE STATE WILL HAVE AN OPPORTUNITY TO CALL REBUTTAL WITNESSES AT NEXT WEEK'S ---

THE ARTICLE REPORTED THAT JUDGE HAGGERTY HAS SAID HE PLANS TO CALL PERSONS FROM THE JURY VENIRE TO QUESTION THEM AS TO WHETHER PUBLICITY ABOUT THE CASE HAD RENDERED THEM INCAPABLE OF MAKING AN IMPARTIAL DECISION.
