THE AFTICLE STATED THAT THE DEFENDE ALSO REQUESTED OF GARRISON COPIES OF ALL PRESS RELEASES AND PUBLIC STATEMENTS AND SPEECHES MADE BY HIM OR MEMBERS OF HIS STAFF CONCERNING SHAW OR THE ASSASSINATION PROBE; COPIES OF ALL SUBPOENAES ISSUED BY THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFIDE FOR THE GRAND JURY IN CONNECTION WITH THE ASSASSINATION INVESTIGATION AND A COPY OF THE INVESTIGATIVE REPORT DEALING WITH AN ALLEGED ATBTEMPTED BATTERY OF JIM HICKS.
