NOTE CONTINUED:

This tape recording was made by the Miami, Florida, Police Department 11-9-63 of a conversation between one of their informants and Joseph Adams Milteer, an anti-integration racist. During this conversation Milteer said plans were in the making to kill President Kennedy at some future date and this could be done from an office or hotel in the vicinity of the White House with a high-powered rifle. This information has been previously brought to our attention. Our investigation of Milteer showed no connection with the assassination, and information concerning the threat was disseminated to the Department and to Secret Service.
