Dear Miss Busselle: I have received your communication of March 4th, together with the letter sent to Senator Kennedy from Miss Harriet A. . Clemens of Decatur, Michigan.

In response to her comments, the FBI, at the direction of President Johnson, conducted a prompt, intensive, objective and thorough investigation of the assassination of President Kennedy. The results of this investigation were accurately reported to the Warren Commission, and not one shred of evidence has been developed to link any other person in a conspiracy with Lee Harvey Oswald to assassinate President Kennedy. All available evidence and facts point to one conchision-that Oswald acted alone in his crime.

You may also wish to advise Miss Clemens that Lec Harve Oswald was never an employee or "Agent" of the FBI nor did he have any alliliation whatsoever with this Bureau.

I am returning Miss Clemens' letter since you may wish 89. Ily so G to keep it in your files.
