his actions were very erratic at which time he had to be escorted from the Los Angeles Office. He appeared at the Los Angeles Office on 2/14/68, at which time he had information regarding the assassination of President Kennedy, which he had received from "unrevealed sources." Due to [redacted] very erratic and irresponsible behavior, background information concerning him should be promptly disseminated to United States Secret Service; the Department and CIA; the latter agency [redacted] claims is responsible for the assassination.
