FBI OFFICE BUILDING
NEW YORK CITY
MARCH 11, 1968

Supervisor Illig, New York Office, advised that at 2:15 p. m. today two individuals appeared at the 69th Street entrance of the building where our New York Office is located carrying placards. These placards read "FBI and CIA Killed Kennedy."

The two demonstrators were of Latin origin, possibly Puerto Rican, and they were only in front of the building for a short period of time and departed prior to the time Agents arrived on the scene.

Supervisor Illig advised that the two demonstrators caused no disturbance and to his knowledge there was no press coverage of this short demonstration.
