The two men showed HAMPTON two photographs indicating that the photographs might be of his brother, CLINTON ARTHUR HAMPTON. Both of these photographs were of an individual in the company of a police officer. HARRY HAMPTON stated that there was a resemblance of the individual in the photographs to his brother, CLINTON ARTHUR HAMPTON. BOFFONX 1947. HARRY HAMPTON advised the two men that his brother now resides with his father, RUSSELL B. HAMPTON, Box 2254, St. Thomas, Virgin Islands. HARRY HAMPTON stated that his brother was in the Air Force in Texas at the time of the assassination. It would appear that HARRY HAMPTON was probably shown photographs similar to the photograph which appeared recently in newspapers together with an article indicating that New Orleans District Attorney GARRISON was offering a reward to anyone who could identify the unknown individual in the photograph. article also indicated that the person in the photo-32- Bureau 2 - Dallas (89-43)H.
