Reached in Gravel's office today, Burnes refused to make any comment on his resignation.

"Many attorneys join the DA's staff to gain experience, then move on to other jobs," Alcock said. He said the Alexandra and the Alexandra andria position offered Burnes "a much better financial arrangement."

Last year another Garrison side, William Curvich, left the DA's staff in disagreement over the prosecution of Clay L. Shaw, who is charged with the properties of the properti conspiracy to assassinate President John F. Kennedy.
