THE NEW ORLEANS STATES-ITEM, RED COMET EDITION, IN
ITS ISSUE OF MARCH TWENTYTWO INSTANT REPORTED THAT DEFENSE
ATTORNEYS FOR CLAY L. SHAW FILED INTO EVIDENCE TODAY IN
THEIR PLEA FOR A CHANGE OF VENUE A LETTER DA JIM GARRISON
WROTE TO THE FEDERAL COMMUNICATIONS COMMISSION.

THE LETTER, THE ATTORNEYS SAID, STATES THAT SHAW FAILED
TO SUBMIT TO A LIE DETECTOR TEST.

THE LETTER ATTORNEYS TOLD JUDGE EDWARD A. HAGGERTY, JR.
ADDS TO THE UNFAVORABLE PUBLICITY CONCERNING SHAW.

GARRISON WROTE THE LETTER IN RESPONSE TO A NATIONAL
BROADCASTING COMPANY PROGRAM WHICH CRITICIZED DA GARRISON
FOR THE METHODS EMPLOYED IN CONDUCTING HIS INVESTIGATION
INTO THE ASSASSINATION OF THE PRESIDENT.
