Re Dallas airtel to Bureau dated 1/19/68, and accompanying LHM which contained information relating to the personal property of MARINA N. OSWALD PORTER and her deceased husband, LEE HARVEY OSWALD, for assistance of the Department in defending a civil suit, captioned "MARINA N. OSWALD PORTER, et al, versus the United States of America (U.S.D.C.-N.D. Texas, Civil Action No. CA-3-2282, Dallas Division)."

Enclosed for the Bureau is one copy of a newspaper clipping appearing in the "Dallas Morning News", Dallas, Texas, on 2/22/68 captioned "\$500,000 Value Placed on Oswald Paraphernalia" reflecting a 17 page deposition was taken 1/31/68 from MARINA OSWALD PORTER, whose legal advisors had suggested she value certain paraphernalia belonging to the late LEE HARVEY OSWALD at \$500,000.
