Enclosed herewith are the original and five copies of an LHM setting forth results of an interview with former New Orleans SAC HARRY G. MAYNOR. He was interviewed on 3/27/68 at NYC, by SA HENRY C. LARSEN.

Mr. MAYNOR categorically denied all allegations made by former Security Patrol Clerk WILLIAM S. WALTER relative to receipt of an alleged communication from FBI Headquarters on 11/17/63, regarding an assassination attempt on the President. Mr. MAYNOR also denied instructing Special Agent personnel investigating the assassination to resolve conflicts in reports by changing, altering or destroying investigative reports.
