Enclosed is one copy of an article from the May 3, 1968 issue of the Swiss-German-language newspaper "Blick." "Blick" has the reputation in Switzerland of being a sensation-mongering sheet.

According to the article, the attempt on DE GAULLE and the assassination of President KENNEDY were planned in Switzerland by a "syndicate in political crime." This story originally appeared in the Hungarian party newspaper "Nepszabadsag." CLAY SHAW was allegedly a chief of this syndicate which was concealed under the name of "Centre of World Trade," with headquarters in Basel, Switzerland in a firm known as "PERMINDEX."

Swiss Police sources regard this story as a flight of the imagination.

It is being left to the judgment of the Bureau as to whether this article should be translated.
