Date June 28, 1968

Attached teletype reports  
 Layton P. Martens arrested in New Orleans  
 June 27, 1968 for attempted murder.  
 Martens is a homosexual who lived with  
 the late David William Ferrie at one  
 time. Garrison claims Martens involved  
 in assassination of President Kennedy.  
 Garrison questioned Martens before Orleans  
 Parish Grand Jury after which Martens  
 was indicted for perjury. We have  
 previously disseminated information to  
 the Department re Martens. Inasmuch as  
 data in attached teletype appeared in  
 news media, no dissemination being made  
 of this information.
