15. SUMMARY: [REDACTED] Source, identified below, advised of contacts with Subject in London during which Subject claimed possession of a "Mafia contract" for the assassination of deceased President John F. KENNEDY and said to be signed by former President Lyndon B. JOHNSON.

1. Source, [REDACTED] presently employed as [REDACTED] was interviewed by USNAVINSERVOEUR representatives on 6 February 1969. He advised that in approximately mid-December 1968 an individual who identified himself as [REDACTED] came to his (Source's) office. [REDACTED] after very rapidly introducing himself, engaged Source in conversation and proceeded to relate the circumstances of his presence in England. [REDACTED] indicated that he and his wife came to England to settle an estate inheritance of his wife's which amounted to more than a million pounds sterling. [REDACTED] variously identified his wife as a

Canadian citizen; as the sister of [redacted] or a similar title, [redacted] former wife of a Miami, Florida gangster called [redacted], and a relative of [redacted]. [redacted] said to be a well-known Egyptian government official.

[redacted] indicated he and his wife were accustomed to living with wealth but were currently having financial difficulties. Following this first meeting, [redacted] contacted Source twice by telephone and on two additional occasions in person at Source's office. During these meetings, [redacted] borrowed two pounds sterling from Source, tried to borrow more on one occasion, and borrowed about seven shillings from Source's secretary using Source's name as authority to do so, without Source's knowledge. The last contact occurred on Tuesday, 4 February 1969, between 1700 and 1800 at Source's office and the developments on this occasion prompted Source's report to this office. [redacted] asked Source if he were interested in money--"big money." Source replied that he was, "as long as it was legal." [redacted] then generally asked about Source's background and Source indicated he was [redacted]

[redacted], at this point, launched into a disjointed and fragmented story from which Source was able to glean two central elements.

2. The first pertained to the Middle East situation. [redacted] condemned the Israelis and clearly evidenced an anti-Semitic attitude. [redacted] made several statements to the effect that Jews, on a world-wide basis, and especially in the United States, are engaged in activities which would not be believed by the vast majority of people but which were known to him to be factual. [redacted] also spoke of having extensive financial and important personal connections in the Middle East in addition to those of his wife, through her relative [redacted]. According to [redacted] is a very important Egyptian government personality who thinks very highly of [redacted] and wife. [redacted] allegedly sent his personal aircraft to New York City as transportation for [redacted] and his wife, but they were unable to use it.

3. The second element of [redacted] story related to [redacted] wife's previous marriage to [redacted] alleged gangster and resident of Miami, Florida. According to [redacted] at the time of his wife's divorce from [redacted] a few years ago, she took from [redacted] personal safe a document referred to by [redacted] as a "contract." As recalled by Source, the dialogue at this time went essentially as follows: [redacted] first asked Source if he knew what a "contract" was. He then asked if Source knew what a "Mafia contract" was. Source indicated to the affirmative, stating essentially that it is supposed to be an agreement to have someone murdered. [redacted] concurred in this definition and then indicated that such a document contracting the assassination of deceased President John F. KENNEDY had been taken from [redacted] safe by [redacted] wife. [redacted] stated he had the contract and that it was signed by the "head or a senior member of the Mafia, two high-ranking Jews in the government, and Lyndon B. JOHNSON." Prior to disclosing the fourth signature as being that of "Lyndon B. JOHNSON," [redacted] paused and indicated Source should prepare himself for that disclosure. Source indicated that he had already formed the opinion that [redacted] was mentally unbalanced and the allegation that former President Lyndon JOHNSON was a signatory to such a document marked the limit of his tolerance. Thus, at this point, he threw [redacted] out of his office.

4. Source advised that as he later contemplated the possible reasons for [redacted] actions, it occurred to him that his (Source's) own background might
