MISCELLANEOUS - INFORMATION

On February 13, 1969, [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] state witness in Attorney James Garrison's assassination probe, supplied the following information to a representative of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI):

[REDACTED] stated that recently he learned from an undisclosed source that the American Telephone and Telegraph Company (AT&T) was "bugging" his home telephone in [REDACTED], Ohio. [REDACTED] advised that the initiating arrangements for the bugging were instituted by a United States Secret Service Agent. He further stated that in the near future, he would initiate a suit against AT&T regarding this matter; and utilizing [REDACTED] Louisiana, attorney who was described by [REDACTED], as his attorney.

[REDACTED] further stated that he believes the United States Secret Service is presently interested in both sides of District Attorney Garrison's probe and is collecting information in this matter widely.
