1. (S) ON 11 APR 69, SUBJ APPEARED AS A WALK-IN AT BLN STA AND
STATED IN SUBS AS FOL/ SUBJ IS A FORMER CIC OFFICER, RETIRED IN
THE RANK OF CPT FOR PHYSICAL DISABILITY. HE PRESENTED VALIN-
APPEARING IDENTIFICATION PAPERS TO SUBSTANTIATE HIS CLAIM. FOL
HIS RETIREMENT IN 62, SUBJ CLAIMED HE HAD WORKDE AS AN INVESTIGATOR
FOR CIA FROM 62 TO 63. ONE OF HIS ASSIGNMENTS WAS TO INVESTIGATE
MARINA OSWALD AND LEE HARVEY OSWALD IN CONNECTION WITH OSWALD'S
ASSOCIATION WITH THE FAIR PLAY FOR CUBA COMMITTEE. AFTER THE
ASSASSINATION OF PRES KENNEDY, SUBJ WAS ARRESTED AND CONVICTED OF
ATTEMPTED BANK ROBBERY IN KALLAS TEX. AND SENTENCED TO FOUR AND
ONE-HALF YRS IN PRISON. HE ALLEGED THAT HE WAS REALLY JAILED
FOR HIS ASSOCIATION WITH THE OSWALD INVESTIGATIONS BECAUSE HE
KNEW TOO MUCH. SUBJ THEN RELATED A CONFUSED XTROY OF HIS RELEASE

IN PRISON ON A PARDON, HIS LOSS OF CONTACT W/HIS WIFE AND
FAMILY, HIS TRAVLS TO EUROPE, AND PROMISSS MADE TO HIM BY
VARIOUS REPRESENTATIVES OF THE CIA AND STATE DEPARTMENT, NONE OF
WHICH WERE KEPT. ON ONE OCASION IN 1968, SUBJ WAS TAKEN FR A
TRAIN AND QUESTIONED BY MFS IN SZG ON A TRIP FR FRG TO US. HE
WAS RELEASED TO WB IN OCT 68 AND HAD A NEWSPAPER CLIPPING FROM A
WASHINGTON, D.C. NEWSPAPER CONCERNING THIS EVENT. SUBJ WAS ASKED
TO WRITE AND ACCOUNT OF HIS EXPERIENCES WHICH HE STARTED TO DO, BUT
REFUSED TO COMPLETE BECAUSE HE BECAME TOO EMOTIONAL AS HE WROTE.
SUBJ WANTED USI TO AID HIM BY "PRESERVING" THE STATE DEPARTMENT AND
THE CIA TO KEEP THEIR "PROMISES" TO HIM.
A CHR W/USBR REVEALED THAT SUBJ WAS KNOW TO MR. H. K.
HILL, VISA OFFICER, IN THE CONSULAR SECTION WHO WAS WORKING ON HIS
CASE. SUBJ WAS CONSIDERED TO BE MENTALLY DISTURBED AS A RESULT OF
AN AIRPLANE ACCIDENT OF WHICH HE WAS NOT ONLY SURVIVOR. HE WAS ALSO
WOUNDED SEVERAL TIMES IN THE KOREAN CONFLICT AND HAS 100 PER CENT DIS-
ABILITY RETIREMENT. HILL REQUESTED THAT SUBJ BE REFERRED TO HIM AS
HE HAD BEEN WAITING SUBJ TO RETURN FOR FURTHER PROCESSING OF HIS
CASE. SUBJ WAS THEN SENT TO THE CONSULAR OFFICES AS REQUESTED.
SUBSEQUENT TO THE ADV, BERLIN STATION RECEIVED A REPORT FR
SEPT 1, US POLICE, THAT SUBJ HAD APPEARED THERE AND RELATED A
VARIATION OF THE STORY GIBBN ABV. HILL WAS NOTIFIED OF SUBJ'S
