Enclosed for information are two Xerox copies of a "confidential" telegram dated 4/22/69 regarding the subject and sent by the 66th Military Intelligence Group, U. S. Army, Europe, to this office and other addressees. It deals with the subject, [REDACTED], who was a walk-in to the Berlin Station of the 66th Military Intelligence Group on 4/11/69. He claims to be a retired military man, who, following retirement, worked as an investigator for CIA; was involved in the LEE HARVEY OSWALD case; and was arrested and sentenced for alleged bank robbery since he "knew too much." He was determined to be mentally disturbed.

Bonn has no prior record on subject.
