OSWALD, 4907 Magazine, New Orleans, La., EVERYONE WELCOME!"

On August 16, 1963, two persons, one of which is bolieved identical with OSWALD, who identified themselves as being connected with the Fair Play for Cuba Committee (FPCC), distributed pamphlets in front of the International Trade Mart in New Orleans. They remained in that location for only a fow moments and departed. This latter information was furnished on August 16, 1963, by the second second second contractual relationship with the International Trade Mart and is a source of information relative to Latin American matters of the New Crieans Office.
