Suit Filed Over JFK Death Probe

LOS ANGELES (UPI) — A man who was drawn into the Kennedy assassination investigation by New Orleans Dist. Atty. James Garrison has filed a \$1.5 million damage suit. **LA.**

Among the six defendants named by Edgar Eugene Bradley were Garrison, writer Mark Lane and the assassination inquiry committee.

Bradley, 52, West Coast representative for radio evangelist Dr. Carl McIntire, charged defamation and malicious prosecution in the suit.

Gov. Ronald Reagan rejected an extradition from Garrison based on a fugitive warrant issued by the New Orleans district attorney.

At that time, Bradley said in his suit, he was considering running for Congress but the publicity ruined any chances he might have had.
