On 6/6/75 SA JAMES P. HOSTY, JR. was telephonically contacted at the Kansas City Office by MARTIN RALBOVSKY, who stated he was a reporter with the Houston, Texas "Chronicle". RALBOVSKY stated he was reviewing a book entitled "Assassination Tapes" by O'TOOLE and wished to get the comments of SA HOSTY. He was directed to the FBIHQ External Affairs Division in Washington, D.C. for any comment.

In view of the fact that the main allegation against SA HOSTY in this book is based upon what is now an admitted hoax by Houston, Texas "Post" reporter LONNIE HUDKINS and former Assistant District Attorney WILLIAM ALEXANDER, the Bureau may care to comment in this matter.
