dward J. Pullman, a North llas psychological counselor d hypnetherapist, broke an year silence to tell The mcs Herald about his oneear friendship with the slayer f accused presidential assas. in Lee Harrey Orwald.

"Jack loved President Kennedy and he was very emotionally disturbed by his leath," Pullman said. "He had kind of father-fixation on the

resident. "He called me the night after-Kennedy was killed and he was crying. He said, The thing that bothers me most is that Jackie (Kennedy) will have to come down here and face that little s.o.b at the

trial." In early 1964, Pullman was questioned by two attorneys for the Warren Commission, but "they didn't seem interesicd" in what he had to say.

If Ruby was a party to a conspiracy to "shut Oswald" mouth," as some assassination bulls have suggested, he was an unwitting party, Pullman

"It's concrivable that some believes. body could have used Jack because he was such a wellknown bothead.

"For this reason, and because of some of the new evidence that has turned up, I'd like to see the assassination investigation respented."

Pullman Sald became aware of how strong were about Ruby's feelings Kennedy one evening when he and his wife were visiting Ruby's Carou cl Club.
