Reference is made previous communications between the FBI and John J. Buckley, Jr., Special Assistant to the Attorney General, concerning contacts Mr. Buckley has had with Professor Richard Popkin. In these contacts Professor Popkin has alleged that a Richard C. Nagell possesses information vital to the assassination of President Kennedy.

The Department of Justice Records Administration Office forwarded to the FBI three telegrams from Professor Popkin to the Attorney General, which were received by the General Investigative Division on 6/19/75.

Since it did not appear that Mr. Buckley had seen the telegrams, he was telephonically contacted on 6/19/75. He had not seen the material and requested that it be sent to him and he would handle the contact with Professor Popkin.

The material has been sent to Mr. Buckley.
