Enclosed for receiving offices are two copies each of a letter received at FBIHQ from Roger Kaye, Edmonton, Alberta, Canada.

This letter sets forth information concerning Joey Maxim, who, according to Kaye, is a former light heavyweight title holder. Maxim allegedly lives in Edmonton, Alberta, Canada, and was recently released from prison in Saskatchewan after serving 12 years. Kaye states Maxim has told him the "underworld" intends to kill former President Nixon and there will be attempts on the lives of President Ford, Secretary of State Henry Kissinger, Senator Edward Kennedy, and Prime Minister Trudeau of Canada. Maxim has also made comments to Kaye about the assassination of former President Kennedy, about Frank Sinatra, and about the "Mafia" and his connections with it in Chicago.

In view of the threats against persons protected by the U. S. Secret Service (USSS), a copy of this letter has been made available by FBIHQ to that agency; USSS is making arrangements for interviews of Kaye and Maxim and will furnish the results of that investigation to the FBI.

FBIHQ files contain no information identifiable with Maxim.

Kaye sent several letters and telegrams to FBIHQ between 1971-1974, primarily concerning alleged "Mafia" activities. He appears to be a [redacted] and his letter is not being acknowledged. Past communications from him have not been acknowledged.

Boston, Los Angeles and WFO alert appropriate local authorities regarding alleged threats against former President Nixon, President Ford, Secretary of State Kissinger and Senator Kennedy.

Legat, Ottawa alert appropriate authorities concerning alleged threat against Canadian Prime Minister Trudeau.

FBIHQ will forward results of USSS inquiry to concerned offices when received.

NOTE:

By letter of 6/9/75 to the Director, Roger Kaye set forth several allegations regarding a Joey Maxim, including information concerning threats against several prominent people. Kaye, who has corresponded with FBIHQ on several occasions, is apparently a [REDACTED]. His past allegations have primarily dealt with the "Mafia" and have not been acted upon or acknowledged. In view of this latest letter containing information of a threatening nature, appropriate receiving offices are being instructed to notify local authorities. A copy of the letter has been made available to SA Don Bell, Liaison Section, U. S. Secret Service Headquarters. That agency is making arrangements for appropriate investigation in Canada and will furnish results to FBIHQ.
