A review of the interview with RICHARD MONROE MARGESON  
has been conducted and New Orleans concurs with the recommendation  
of Dallas that no further action is needed.

New Orleans' files do reveal that according to  
newspaper articles appearing in New Orleans newspapers during  
January, 1968, reporting District Attorney GARRISON's  
investigation, GARRISON expressed an interest in LAWRENCE J.  
HOWARD, JR., as a material witness in his probe. These articles  
further reported that according to HOWARD's attorney he was  
afraid to let HOWARD return to New Orleans. Instead of  
returning to New Orleans, HOWARD had requested GARRISON to send  
someone to Los Angeles to take his deposition but stated he had  
no special information to provide GARRISON. These articles  
further indicate that according to HOWARD he had previously  
been interviewed by the FBI.

A subsequent article indicated that HOWARD had come to  
New Orleans and conferred with GARRISON.
