On August 29, 1975, J. E. "Fbb" Rose, President of Trucking Company, Houston, Texas, was interviewed and he furnished the following information:

Trucking Company, Houston, Texas, advised that he knew

Trucking Company but he does not have any idea what
he has been doing for the past several years. He stated
that, to the best of his recollection, was a truck that, to the best of his recollection, was a truck driver for the company in Houston, Texas, and in Montebello, California. He stated that he has never given obviously heard of LEE HARVEY OSWALD, he did not know him.

ROSE advised he was acquainted with ROY HILLIARD who formerly was employed by Trucking Company and who was formerly a highway patrolman. He stated that HILLIARD is currently working in Dallas, Texas, as a security guard. ROSE advised he has never associated socially with with him on any occasion. He stated that he does not know why terminated his employment with trucking why terminated his employment with trucking company but that he would obtain his personner file and determine if there is any information contained therein which would enlighten the situation. which would enlighten the situation.

The personnel file furnished by Mr. ROSE indicated that that was born December 4, 1933. His social Security number is the indicated that he received an honorable discharge from the U.S. Army and served in the Korean conflict. The record indicated that he was in the Army from January 4, 1951 to September 8, 1952 and was discharged as a sergeant. Mr. Marshall Ray Moore was interviewed and furnished the following information:

MARSHALL RAY MOORE advised that he remembered Trucking Company. He stated that he had worked in Houston for the company, as well as in California for their Montebello terminal. He stated that was a dark-haired individual to the best of his recollection and was the type of individual who liked to exert his authority on persons under him. MARSHALL MOORE stated that had some lesser supervisory job at the Montebello terminal but was not an assistant terminal manager. He stated in his position he exerted undue authority over other people connected with the company and caused considerable trouble among the employees.

He stated was not a good employee and quit his employment with the company just before he would have been fired. MARSHALL MOORE stated that was just not in harmony with other employees. He stated he was aware of a confrontation that he had with two other employees, one of whom was JACK WATKINS who was a driver for the company. He stated that JACK WATKINS and his brother confronted on one occasion when was in his car because of past actions regarding the brothers and during the course of the confrontation, sped away in the car dragging JACK WATKINS with him. He stated that WATKINS was quite severely injured as a result of this action by He stated this was no attempt by the WATKINS brothers to kill for any reason and was merely an attempt by two employees who were fed up with and overbearing attitude. MOORE stated that JACK WATKINS is still with the Trucking Company and is currently in Odessa, Texas.

Boulevard in Dallas, as the trucks normally took the road past the circle on Harry Mines Boulevard chroute to Oklahoma He stated there was, in fact, a ship-type restaurant on Harry Hines Boulevard and elso there were two motels on the circle, namely the Tower Motel and the Circle Motel. He stated that the terminal in Dallas is across town from the circle and that there normally would be no reason for the truckers to stop at the circle.
