Mrs. TIPPETT was allegedly an alcoholic. They had been seen together many times while drinking at an unknown bar and cafe. One of their waitresses at the bar said she had poured hot coffee down OSWALD's throat many times to sober him up so he could go home before Officer TIPPETT was due to get off work and possibly catch his wife and OSWALD together. A woman, name unknown, whose husband was a bouncer or doorman at Ruby's Nightclub in Dallas, said her husband saw TIPPETT, OSWALD and RUBY together at RUBY's club two nights prior to the assassination of President KENNEDY. The woman also said her husband had seen TIPPETT and OSWALD together in RUBY's club more than once before the assassination.

 News Building and said, "President Kennedy

The above-mentioned anonymous telephone caller furnished this information to SA and stated she had been contacted by SA in the past and would recontact him if she could obtain the name of the waitress mentioned in (1) above, as well as the man and woman mentioned in (2) above. SA was unable to identify the unknown caller.

On 9/4/75, the anonymous idividual again called the Dallas Office of the FBI and furnished the following information to SA

She has been successful in identifying the waitress who furnished the information about the alleged affair between Mrs. TIPPETT and LEE HARVEY OSWALD. She stated the waitress is a Mrs. present address unknown. She believed Mrs. has moved to the Gasa Linda area of North Mesquite, Texas, exact address again unknown.
