 On September 11, 1975, Ms. Brooke Janis, CBS News, New York City, telephonically contacted Special Agent Cortlandt Cunningham regarding the panel of firearms experts in a court ordered examination of the evidence obtained during the captioned assassination. She advised that she had heard from CBS Attorneys that Mr. Cunningham had been nominated to be on the panel.

She was advised that the only information he had was that the Director had authorized a nomination to such a panel and it was not known whether or not he would be appointed. She, further, stated that CBS News was planning for a November four-hour Special on "assassinations" including the captioned assassination. D
