AN AIRMAIL COPY OF A TELETYPE FROM SAC, DALLAS. TO DIRECTOR DATED NOV. 17, 1963, AND CAPTIONED "UNSUB; BOMB IN BAKER HOTEL, DALLAS, TEXAS, NOV. 17, 1963. BOMBING MATTERS-THREAT," WAS LOCATED. THIS TELETYPE RELAYED DALLAS PD INFORMATION WHICH REPORTED THE RECIEPT OF AN ANONYMOUS PHONE CALL BY ONE FNU MC KINNON ADVISING, "THERE WILL BE A BOMB IN THE BAKER TOMORROW." ACCORDING TO DALLAS PD, MC KINNON REPORTEDLY WAS ON THE WELCOMING COMMITTEE FOR ALABAMA GOVERNOR GEORGE WALLACE, WHO ARRIVED IN DALLAS THE EVENING OF NOV. 17, 1963, AND WAS STAYING AT THE BAKER HOTEL.
