On 10-14-75, [redacted], nee [redacted], white female, age 37, address: [redacted] Marina, DeLand, Florida, mailing address: [redacted] DeLand, Florida, advised she has been separated from her husband, [redacted], for approximately one year. She stated she is currently using the name [redacted] however, she has not been divorced from [redacted].

[redacted] stated her husband, [redacted], is in the antique business with [redacted], whom she vaguely knows, of Daytona Beach, Florida. [redacted] said [redacted] made frequent trips to Atlanta, Georgia, to haul produce to the farmers' market as well as hauling antiques to various antique shows in Georgia and Alabama.

She advised of having no knowledge of any documents or materials her husband or [redacted] may have possessed concerning the assassination of President [redacted].

[REDACTED] stated approximately two years ago, date not recalled, [REDACTED] loaded two or three brown cardboard boxes from his place of business in Port Orange, Florida, and placed them on his truck, and, as she recalls, he was taking them to an antique auction some place, location unknown, in Georgia. She stated, to her knowledge, the boxes would have contained books, pictures, or other typical type merchandise that would be sold at small antique auctions. She advised she did not see the contents of the boxes and has no idea as to what the boxes actually contained. She advised it would not be uncommon for her former husband to haul boxes containing pictures and books to various auctions.

She advised [REDACTED] never discussed or mentioned anything concerning the above captioned matter. [REDACTED] advised she would be willing to provide any information as it pertained to the captioned matter, and would like to assist in her former husband's release from jail as he was a good provider for her two children.
