

William S. Valter, forper Security patrol Cleric, New Orleans Office of the FBI, was interviewed by Robert G. Jensen, Special Agent in Charge, Lenpais Office of the FBI, and Special Agent Yilliam D. I recall that sometine during my tour of duty (nidnight to 8:00 a.m.) on zovenber 27, 1963, I received a teletype from FBI Readquatiers.
