An analysis of the teletype communication indicates it did not originate from the Bureau. The distinctive wording of the teletype did not follow the normal format of issuing instructions of type by the Bureau during that particular period of time. All offices would have been instructed to contact all Racial, and Criminal informants and logical sources (not limited to "Racial" and hate group informants, Security informant/ was not mentioned). The reliability of the sources and the name/ of group would normally be included. (Not general classification, , , militant revolutionary group.") No instructions given regarding, advice to State and local authorities and Secret Service.
