Your communication of October 31st to the Department of Justice, enclosing a copy of a letter from Messrs. Steve Willnow and Robert Carlson, Allendale, Michigan, was forwarded to the FBI for acknowledgment and was received here on November 10th.

With respect to your constituents' request, this Bureau has received numerous letters urging that the investigation into the assassination of President Kennedy be reopened. I have responded by saying that in every instance new leads are investigated, but to date, no evidence has been received that would indicate this investigation should be reopened.
