UNSUB; AKA [REDACTED] ALLEGED INFO REGARDING JOHN F. KENNEDY ASSASSINATION, ALLEGED INFO REGARDING ATTEMPTED ASSASSINATION OF SENATOR EDWARD KENNEDY; ASSAULT ON PRESIDENT.

ON DECEMBER 4, 1975, CAPTAIN GEOFFREY G. PROSCH, SUPERINTENDENT'S AIDE, UNITED STATES MILITARY ACADEMY, WEST POINT, NEW YORK, ADVISED APPROXIMATELY 10:30 PM, DECEMBER 3, 1975, HE RECEIVED TELEPHONE CALL FROM INDIVIDUAL IDENTIFYING HIMSELF AS [REDACTED], NEW YORK CITY, NY, AND A MEMBER OF THE B' NAI B' RITH WHO WANTED TO SPEAK TO LIEUTENANT GENERAL SIDNEY BERRY, SUPERINTENDENT. CAPTAIN PROSCH DECLINED TO PUT CALLER THROUGH TO GENERAL BERRY. CALLER ADVISED HE HAD HIRED INTELLIGENCE REGARDING ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY AND ON UP COMING ASSASSINATION OF SENATOR EDWARD KENNEDY. WANTED GENERAL BERRY NOTIFIED AND TO RETURN HIS CALL. CALLER HUNG UP WITHOUT GIVING REASON CALL TO GENERAL BERRY AND NOT TO FBI OR SECRET SERVICE. CALLER DID NOT LEAVE TELEPHONE NUMBER.
