Re Bureau nitel to Los Angeles dated 12/10/75.

Enclosed for the Bureau are five copies of a letterhead memorandum suitable for dissemination.

Enclosed with referenced communication was a copy of a letter addressed to the U. S. Attorney General from [redacted], inmate, California Men's Colony (CMC), San Luis Obispo, California. As stated in referenced communication, [redacted] is identical with the subject of Los Angeles file [redacted].

As set out in the enclosed letterhead memorandum, [redacted] advised that he did not have any personal knowledge concerning the statements he made in the letter he wrote to the U. S. Attorney General. He advised that the source of his information was an inmate named [redacted], who he described as being approximately 83 years old.

[redacted] was not interviewed in view of information furnished by staff members at CMC that he has a mental problem, has been a prolific letter writer, and on occasions has insisted that he is some other person, such as the President of the United States.

In view of the above, no communication is being sent to the Chicago Division requesting interview of the person [redacted] referred to in referenced communication.
