4. One 4"x5" photograph which appears to be a copy of the photograph described in item number 1. This photograph was also furnished to New York Office by [redacted] and has the notation on the back, "San Antonio, Texas, 11/21/63." On the face of this photograph appears to be a ballpoint pen notation, "Mi" with an arrow pointing to an individual whom [redacted] identifies as resembling her ex-husband, [redacted]

5. One copy of New York airtel to Bureau, 3/22/77, is enclosed for background information.

As set forth in enclosed New York airtel to the Bureau, 3/22/77, [redacted] pointed out that in the photograph, as described in item number 1 and 4, there is an individual whom she identifies as resembling her ex-husband, [redacted], and also an individual whom she described as resembling LEE HARVEY OSWALD. It is not known to Dallas what individual in the picture [redacted] thought resembled LEE HARVEY OSWALD.

The Technical Analysis Section is requested to conduct appropriate examinations on enclosed photographs (items number 1 and 4) with the enclosed [redacted] photographs (item number 3) to determine if the individual [redacted] marked with "Mi" (item number 4) is identical to the [redacted] (item number 3).

Appropriate examinations are also to be conducted in an effort to determine if any individuals shown in the enclosed photographs (items number 1 and 4) might be similar or identical with photographs of LEE HARVEY OSWALD on file at the STSD.

The STSD is requested to report the results of examinations conducted in a form suitable for inclusion in an LHM.
