[redacted] who uses the name [redacted], residing at [redacted], Texarkana, Arkansas, contacted the Federal Bureau of Investigation, Texarkana, Arkansas, and advised that he had information which he felt related to the assassination of President JOHN F. KENNEDY in 1963 in Dallas, Texas. [redacted] then appeared at the office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation in Texarkana, Arkansas, at which time he was advised that any information furnished should be the truth since the furnishing of false information might place him in violation of federal statutes relating to furnishing false information to federal officers. [redacted] then furnished the following signed statement:
