ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT

1 - Mr. Giaquinto

On September 21, 1977, our Little Rock Division interviewed [redacted] at Texarkana, Arkansas, and obtained the attached signed statement.

In connection with [redacted] it is noted that he resides with his 20-year old daughter and exists on his Social Security check, which he receives on the basis of his physical disability, primarily the fact that he is currently 80% blind.

[redacted] claims he did not initially furnish the information set out in the interview because of the prominent people involved and because of their prominence, he was afraid for his life if he divulged the information set out. Since 1976, when he was advised by his doctor that he in all probability had no more than one to two years to live, he has been considering furnishing this information. He could not offer any explanation as to why he suddenly came forth at this particular time other than that he had made the decision to furnish the information. He also maintained he had no intention of furnishing this information to anyone else and he did not intend to try and capitalize on the information furnished.

[redacted] readily admitted the two instances where he was examined by a psychiatrist as set out in his interview. In this connection, [redacted] talked very coherently and did not evidence the mannerisms frequently associated with a mentally disturbed individual.

[redacted] advised he would be willing to submit to a polygraph examination in connection with information furnished.

[REDACTED], who uses the name [REDACTED], residing at Apartment 18, 2225 East Street, Texarkana, Arkansas, contacted the Federal Bureau of Investigation, Texarkana, Arkansas, and advised that he had information which he felt related to the assassination of President JOHN F. KENNEDY in 1963 in Dallas, Texas. [REDACTED] then appeared at the office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation in Texarkana, Arkansas, at which time he was advised that any information furnished should be the truth since the furnishing of false information might place him in violation of federal statutes relating to furnishing false information to federal officers. [REDACTED] then furnished the following signed statement:
