Dear Sir,

I have been searching the Postal Commission on
the assassination of President Kennedy for the past 3 months in London
& wish to advise you that as a result of these searches I can
say that the above mentioned was NOT involved in the shooting
of President J.F. Kennedy, or Officer Tibbels - he was clearly pointed
by the conspirators. I have advised that ^{person} but that I took the
photograph of man with revolver & air gun which appeared in
Life Magazine; he stated advertising agency, jacket for
clothing at C. S. H. requests in connection with summer
of 1958-1959. There is however the place of investigation
blowing. Miami stated she took a picture of Dallas
Meely Sr in MARCH & some expert stated that species
of plant could not possibly bloom in March. I refer to

I am passing this information as an independent witness & what was a travesty of justice in view of the recently revealed information. Your representative gave testimony before the President Commission Lt Col Allison Fousom & may be initiated as I have little doubt the Marine Corps could get adverse publicity.

The Director F.B.I. has been advised of my former letter; if Lt Col Allison Fousom is still in the Marine Corps he might wish copies of my former letter I would like the F.B.I. to act as a referee to assess the evidence which I have submitted & give a final conclusion on what the evidence was "found" for both shooting of President Kennedy & the other.
