Dear Mr. Ruby:

Until the very moment when it was announced that you had shot the murderous Oswald, there were 120 million suspects, for "who would not act, who had a heart to love, and in that heart courage to make love known?" Any one of your fellow Americans, had he been in the police station, with a gun on his person, to see the miserable Communist--no, not miserable, but meaningless; the sordid, meaningless, insignificant man who had killed the sweetest, the most just, the most beloved leader the sun had ever shown upon---would have shot. Who could have restrained himself? It might have been different had Oswald been a plotter; perhaps a rebellious General, brilliant and defiant even in this ultimate ~~lead~~ lead of treason; but to see him, a dog, a rat who had bitten our dearest President. The wonder is not that you shot him; the wonder is that every man there in that cellar did not throw himself at his throat.

Not, of course, that I believe that your deed was right--it was not, even you have said that--oh, but how understandable, how inevitable it was! And although I realized that it was wrong, how I shouted when Oswald was killed, "Good! He is dead! Kennedy is avenged!"

I had ~~thought~~, feared, that the anti-Semites would be able to make ~~some~~ capital out of the fact that a Jew had killed Oswald, but no, I was quite ~~not~~ wrong. The anti-Semites say that the Jews are cunning and devious ---but ~~the~~ Jews can point to you and say, "Here is a Jew of passion! Here is a Jew who, so far from being cunning, was so blinded

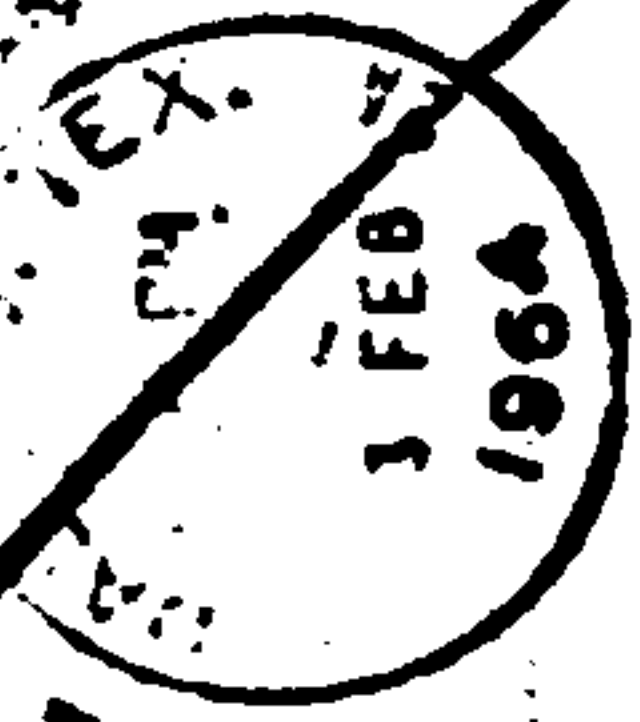
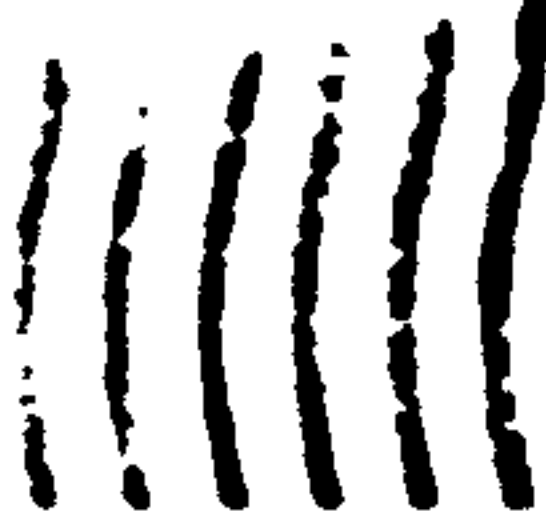

by rage that he cared nothing for his own life, no, not even for right or wrong. Was this devious?"

I thought that you might perhaps be interested in some thoughts that some friends and I had while discussing you--as everyone in America has been discussing you, not always with approval, but usually with understanding. We were all University of Chicago students or graduates, and one of us said, "My professor of philosophy said, 'Ruby is a philosopher. He knew that the people wanted in their hearts, and he did it.'" But I disagreed. No, not a philosopher, but something else.

We then asked if the Kennedy murder was a tragedy, and said, of course it is; how could it not be? Then who is the tragic hero? Kennedy? The tragic hero must cause his own downfall by some tragic fault, and Kennedy was faultless, and did not, certainly not, cause his own destruction; the very thought is treacherous. Who then? Oswald? But a hero must be a good man; no, not him. Then there was only one man left, and it had to be him, or else there was no tragic hero, and so ~~that~~ <sup>to</sup> was no tragedy, but merely melodrama. Jack Ruby, then, was the tragic hero, and his fault was ~~his~~ blinding, passionate devotion to his leader. Indeed, Jack Ruby was something like Hamlet, or rather the opposite of Hamlet, for Hamlet could not act at all, and Ruby acted too quickly. Where Hamlet hesitated, Ruby struck! Where Hamlet could not avenge a father, Ruby could, did, avenge a President. And so, sir, we found that you were a hero, not by the popular meaning of hero, but by the true meaning.

I certainly hope, Mr. Ruby, that you are freed, for if

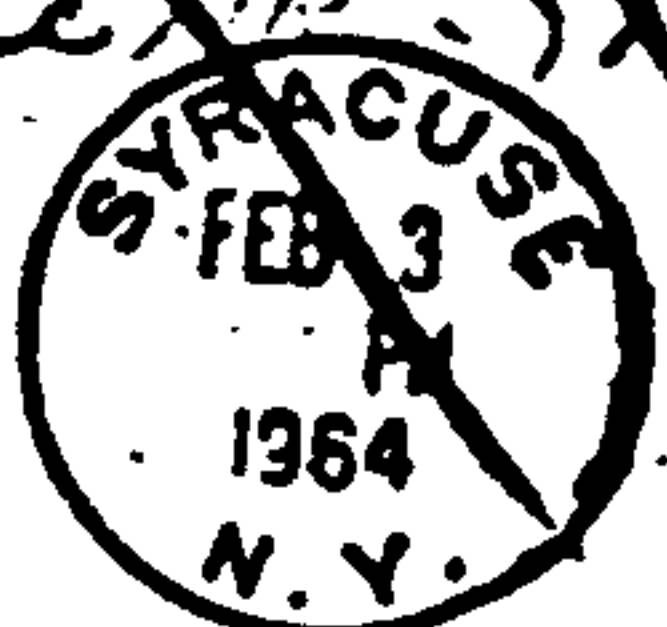

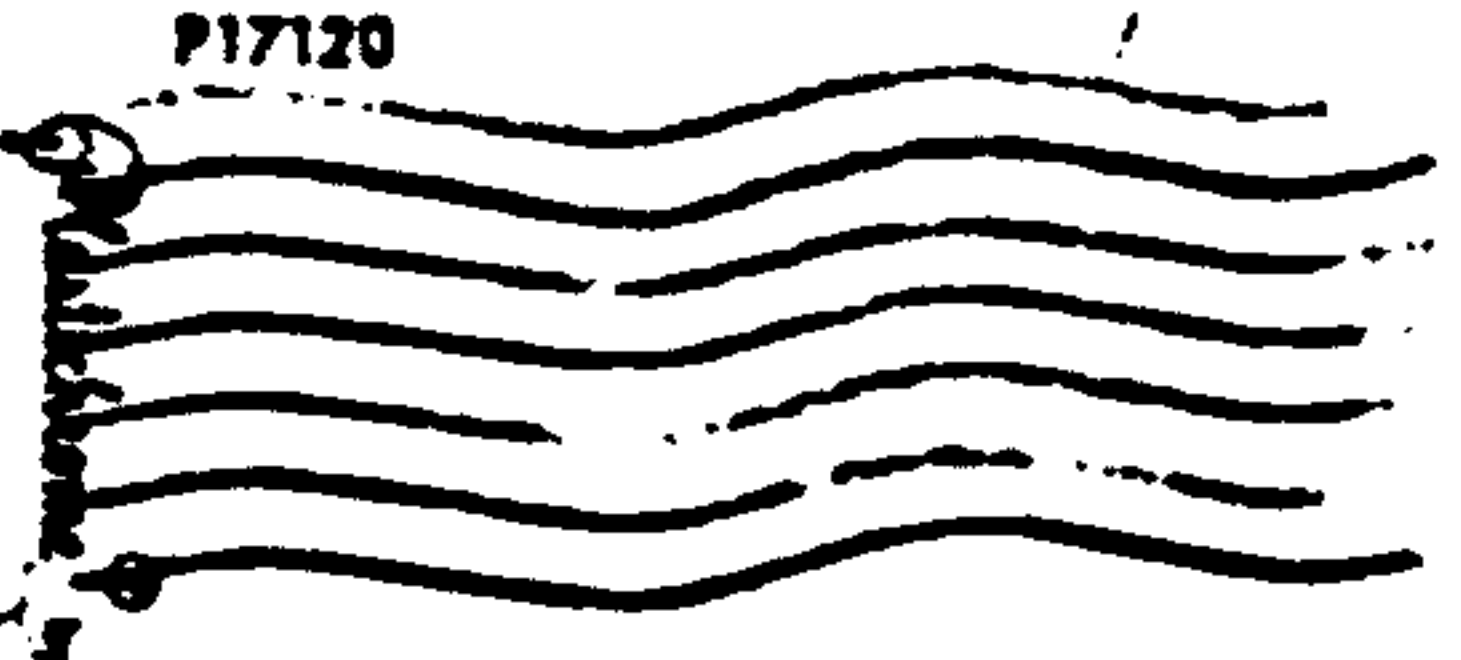
We get very little news from Dallas these days. I hope you are in good health and I hope

"I will insist that the Government get a dollar's value  
for a dollar spent," he said. "The Government will set an  
example of prudence and economy. This does not mean we

**UNUSUAL GESTURE**

In an unusual Presidential gesture and mindful of his  
own background both in the House and Senate, Mr. John-  
son assured Congress of his belief in the independence of  
integrity of the legislative branch.

"I promise you that I shall always respect this," he said.  
"It is deep in the marrow of my bones. With equal firm-  
ness, I believe in the capacity and the ability of the Con-  
gress, despite the divisions of opinion which characterize  
our nation, to act—to act wisely, vigorously and speedily  
when the need arises."

Repeatedly the President asked for congressional coopera-  
tion—and speed in passage of basic legislation which Mr.  
Kennedy had asked.

"This is no time for delay—it is a time for action, strong,  
forward-looking action . . ." he said.

Concluding his address, he said, "the need is here. The  
need is now. I ask your help."

In the wake of President Kennedy's assassination, Mr.  
Johnson also took a strong stand against political extrem-  
ists, right or left.

**URGES TOLERANCE**

"The time has come for Americans of all races and  
creeds and political beliefs to understand and respect one  
another," he said. "Let us put an end to the teaching and  
preaching of hate and evil and violence. Let us turn away  
from the fanatics of the far left and the far right, from  
the apostles of bitterness and bigotry, from those defiant  
of law, and those who pour venom into our nation's blood-  
stream."

Then, in an eloquent climax at the end of his speech,  
Mr. Johnson quoted the lyrics from "America The Beautiful."

"On this Thanksgiving eve," he said, "as we gather to-  
gether to ask the Lord's blessing, let us unite in those  
familiar and cherished words:

"America, America, God shed His grace on thee,

"And crown thy good with brotherhood from sea to  
shining sea," (UPI)

#### Minister Offers Job to Mrs. Oswald

ST. LOUIS, Mo., Nov. 27 (UPI) — Mrs. Lee Harvey Oswald, wife of the accused assassin of President Kennedy, was offered a job and a place to live yesterday by Rev. Bill Beeny, a home-back riding Baptist minister.

The Rev. Mr. Beeny, who is seeking the Democratic nomination for governor, made the offer in a telegram.

"We're doing this with no consideration of whether her husband was guilty," the Rev. Beeny said. "We're doing it as a humanitarian act for a mother and two children who are in need."

The Rev. Mr. Beeny said the offer involved a job at his youth ranch in Wright City, Mo. The minister has been sentenced to three months in prison for operating the ranch without the proper license but has an appeal pending.

#### EXPOSED

#### Letter From a Dead President

## Wheat Accord Block Removed

The Senate, moved by a letter from the dead President, voted last night to give the new Chief Executive a free hand in negotiating the proposed wheat sales to Russia.

By a 57-to-35 vote, the Senate defeated a bill sponsored by Sen. Karl E. Mundt (R, S. D.), that would have prohibited the Export-Import Bank from guaranteeing commercial U. S. bank loans to finance the sales.

Elsewhere on the Hill:

#### Gun Sales

Sen. Thomas J. Dodd (D, Conn.) said today that he would strengthen his bill aimed at curbing sale of mail-order guns. It was such a weapon that killed President Kennedy. The legislation as now written would prohibit interstate shipment of firearms to localities where they are not permitted. It would also bar sale to minors and convicted felons. (UPI)

Canada's Liberal government mapped a national education campaign to discourage young people from smoking.

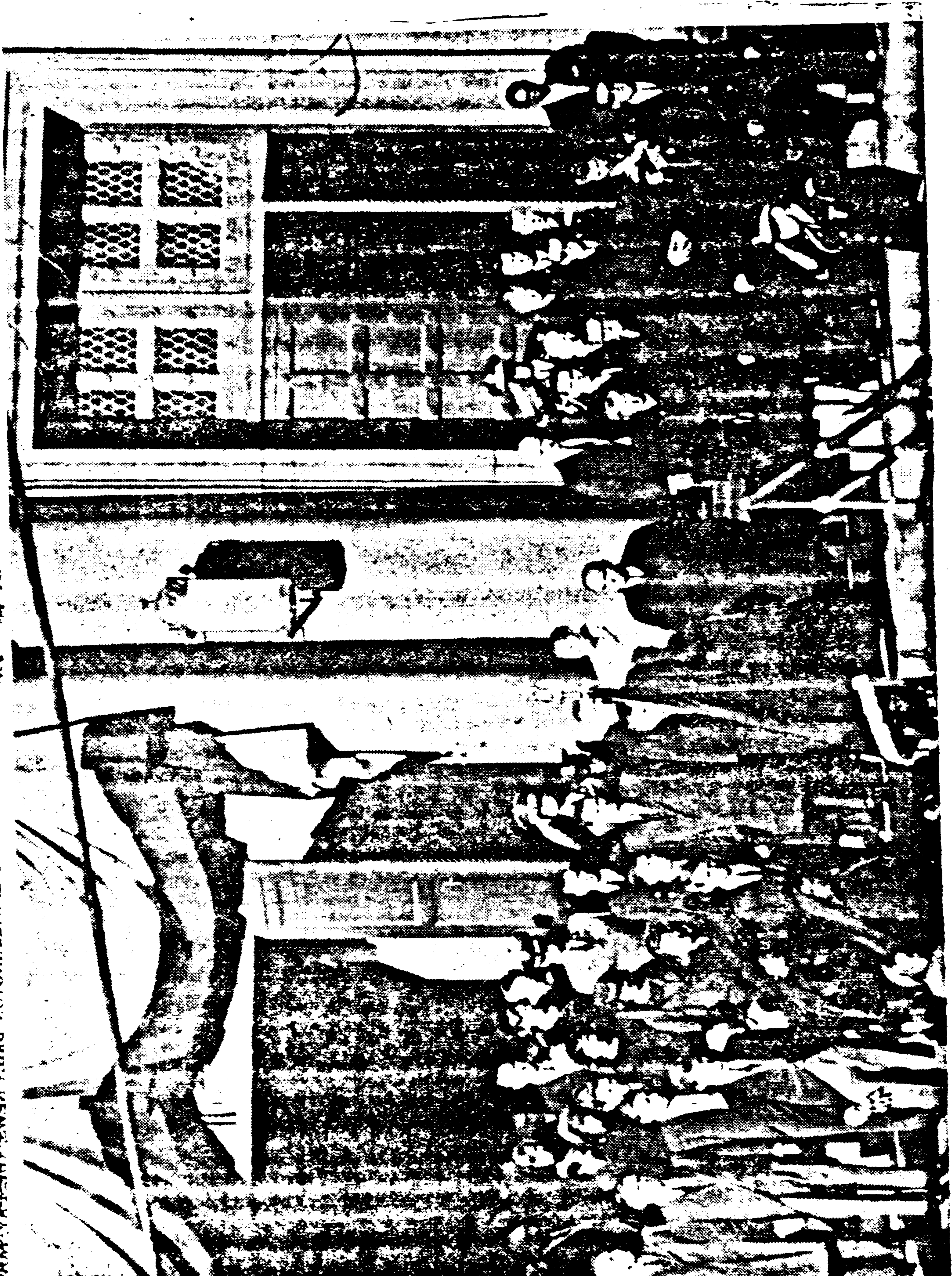

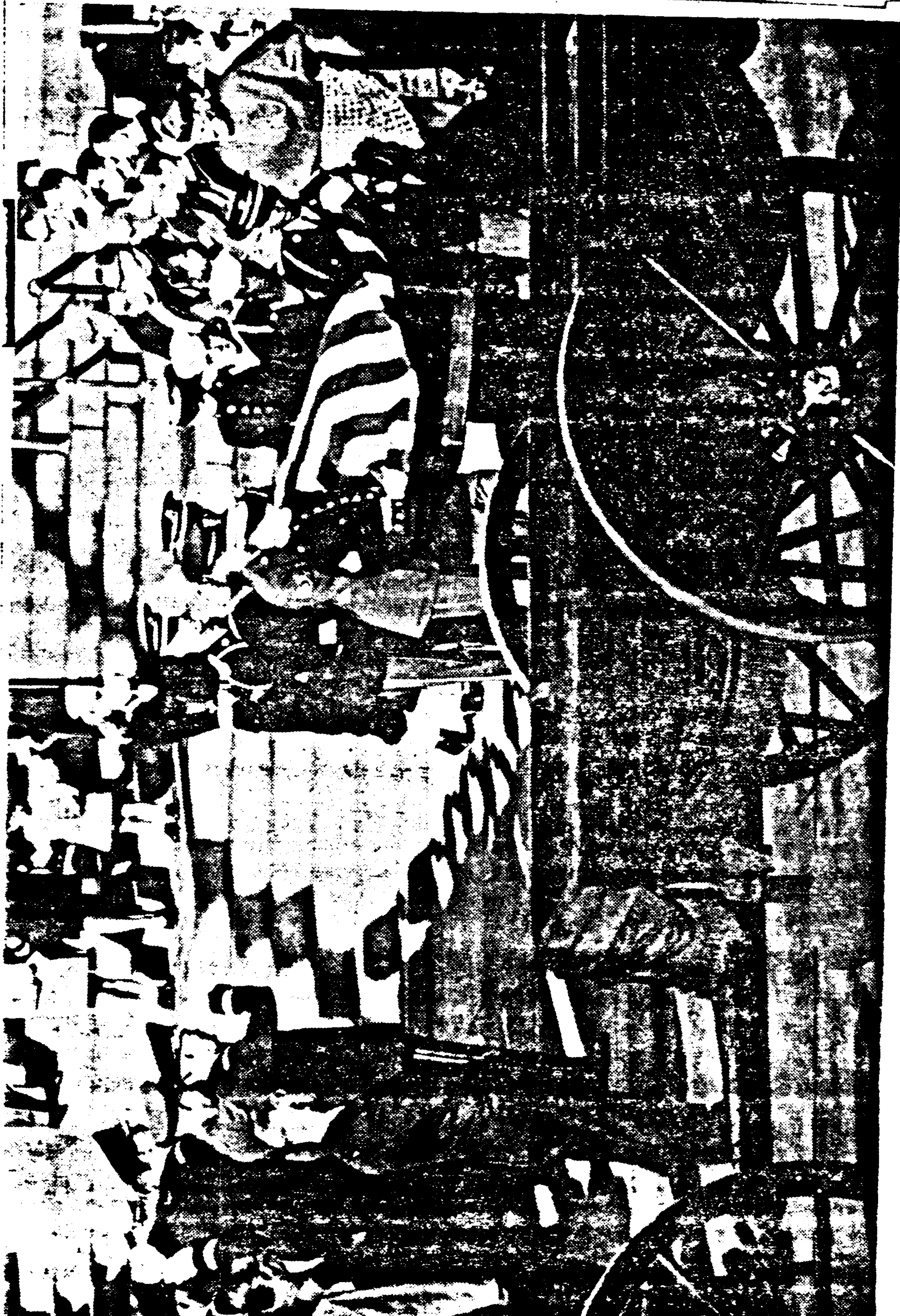

# 'Hot Line' Reportedly Never Used

MOSCOW, Nov. 26 (UPI)—United Press International has learned on the best authority that President Kennedy never used the "hot line" to Premier Nikita Khrushchev.

There had been speculation it might have been used between Moscow and Washington during the worst moments of the Autobahn crisis in Germany in October and early November. It was not.

Not was the emergency communication circuit between the White House and the Kremlin activated when the Russians arrested Prof. Frederick C. Barghoorn on espionage charges. Prof. Barghoorn was released after American protests thru normal channels and President Kennedy's strong demand at a press conference for the professor's freedom.

The "hot line" is designed for brink-of-war situations—to cut thru everything and get to the top on both sides to avoid any misunderstandings that could bring on a nuclear holocaust.

## New Inspector

John W. Trotter, 51, commanding officer of the Ninth Precinct, will be promoted to inspector Dec. 1. He will succeed Inspector Alexander S. Douglass, who is retiring.

Capt. Trotter, a native of Charles County, Md., will be a district inspector assigned to administrative headquarters.

Lieut. William J. Cooperthwaite has been named acting captain of the Metropolitan Police Training School, replacing Inspector Douglass, effective Dec. 1.

## Girl Is Killed Copying JFK's Honor Guard

NEW YORK, Nov. 26 (UPI)—The playful attempts of two young sisters to copy the drills of the Honor Guard at President Kennedy's funeral ended in death for one of them yesterday.

Johanna Malandrucce, 13, was scheduled to appear in Brooklyn Family Court today on juvenile delinquency charges in the fatal shooting of her sister, Mary, 16, at their Brooklyn home.

Detectives said the girls, after watching the ceremony on television, went to the bedroom of their brothers, Joseph, 22, and Donald, 17, a Marine recruit and got the weapons.

Mary playfully pointed an unloaded rifle at her sister and pulled the trigger.

Johanna, in the belief a shotgun also was unloaded, pointed it at Mary, but it discharged.

## UN Pays Final Tribute to JFK

NEW YORK, Nov. 26 (UPI)—The United Nations today postponed all other business to devote the day to a final tribute to President Kennedy.

The General Assembly of 111 nations was convoked to eulogize the President who addressed it last on Sept. 20 with a challenge to Russia to end the cold war and join the United States in "a contest of achievement" including a joint manned moon shot.

Kennedy assassination was closed merely confirms the worst suspicions bred by the earlier police statements without giving evidence that Oswald was the man.

President Johnson called on the nation's houses of worship today to have the late president Kennedy's Thanksgiving Day proclamation read at services Thursday.

The proclamation, Mr. Kennedy's last before he was killed, urged the nation to "express our gratitude for the glorious gifts of God . . . and earnestly and humbly pray that He will continue to guide and sustain us in the great unfinished tasks of achieving peace, justice and understanding among all men."

## A MEMORIAL

Mr. Johnson, in a statement, suggested the proclamation be read "as a memorial" to Mr. Kennedy.

"I also ask that the newspapers and the television and radio stations make it available to all of the American people by including it in their recognition of this first and most solemn of our holidays," the President added.

"We dedicate Thanksgiving

of Texas, and of the United States that may have done more damage to our country than anything that has occurred since the end of the war. Such goings-on in other countries are expected, but to nations dependent on the United States for survival the last four days' events have been a devastating blow. It will require formidable effort by President Johnson to erase this Dallas blot.

Day, as we have for over 300 years, as a day to give thanks to God for his gifts and the sustenance which he has provided in undertaking the tasks of our nation.

**'IDEALS WE INHERIT'**  
The Kennedy proclamation was issued Nov. 5 and urged all to "give our thanks, most of all, for the ideals of honor and faith we inherit from our forefathers."

The Proclamation added: "Let us therefore proclaim our gratitude to providence for manifold blessings — let us be humbly thankful for inherited ideals — and let us resolve to share these blessings and these ideals with our fellow human beings throughout the world." (UPI)

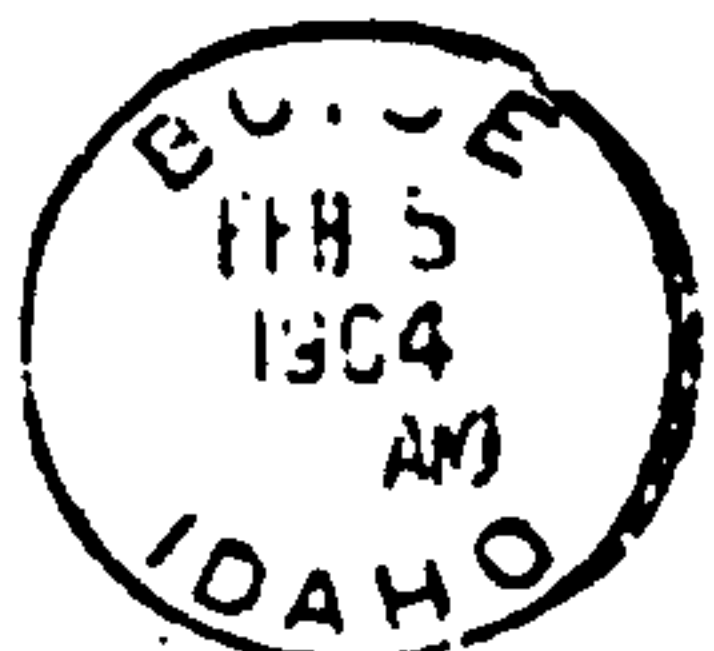

## Ruby's Lawyer Plans to Try Mental Test

NEW YORK (AP)—Jack Ruby's lawyer said Tuesday night he plans a courtroom test of his client's sanity during his coming murder trial, using "various diagnostic procedures and equipment."

The attorney, Melvin Belli of San Francisco, did not elaborate. He talked with newsmen when he arrived at Kennedy Airport for a three-day visit to promote a book he has written.

Belli is seeking to have Ruby's trial for the slaying of Lee Harvey Oswald transferred out of Dallas, where the accused assassin of President Kennedy was shot down Nov. 24. He said if a change of venue is granted, the trial might be postponed for as long as eight months. It now is scheduled to begin Feb. 17.

Belli said of his motion for a change of venue:


"I feel the people of Dallas, perhaps unconsciously, have to have a sacrifice in order to cleanse themselves to prove that Dallas is a law-abiding community. They feel if Ruby is executed it would reestablish some sense of law and order."


P.S. In 1951 I lost my job while working for the Bureau of Land Management, Portland, Oregon - at which time they accused Jack Cohen a previous employer of being the father of my son William - My husband was sick at the time and I had to pawn my imitation ruby ring with four diamonds around it, and with the public persecution by Catholic (one Beatrice VanFoomison of the Fish & Wildlife Service - the employer just before that), and through that abuse I was unable to get another job and lost my ring. It was my dad's stick pin and I valued it highly.

This abuse caused me to have to take two weeks treatment in the Holiday Hospital and 4 months treatment in Blackfoot Mental Hospital (both bills I have never been able to pay for).

They caused a constant buzzing of voices in my hearing.


I hesitate to write this letter, because it can cause the loss of my present job and we are too deeply in debt to lose it.
