THE STORY OF WASHINGTON D. C.

Washington has been the seat of our National government since 1800. Out of a marshy wilderness has sprung one of the most beautiful capitals in the world.

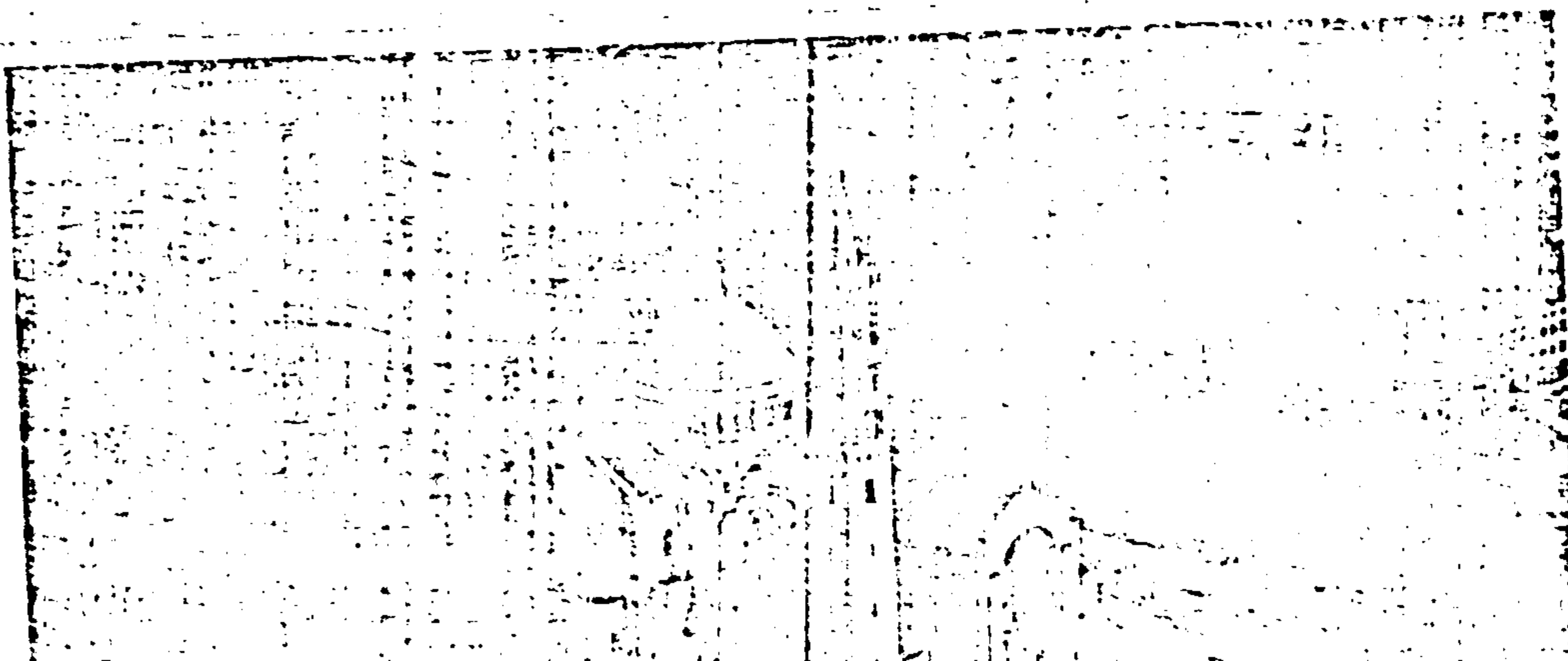
Pierre Charles L'Enfant, an engineer in the Continental Army, planned and designed with great foresight the city that was destined to become the greatest Capital in the world. Recommended by President Washington for this task, L'Enfant selected Capitol Hill as the focal point and laid out broad avenues which radiate like the spokes of a wheel from centers placed within the rectangular pattern of the streets. With only a few exceptions it has been constructed as he suggested.

The site for the city was selected after many attempts had failed owing to the rivalry between the states, the settlement being effected by the efforts of Thomas Jefferson.

In 1791 the commission chose a tract lying on both sides of the Potomac River. The northern part was ceded by Maryland and the southern by Virginia. Later the southern portion was returned to Virginia and the "Territory of Columbia" (as it was known at that time), became the city of "Washington," despite the protests of the great and modest American for whom it was named.

In its early days the city centered around Lafayette Square, reaching east to the Capitol and west to old Georgetown. Many of the colonial houses are still standing in these areas and many more, well worth seeing will be found in nearby Virginia.

In 1900 Washington celebrated the 100th Anniversary of the removal of the seat of Government to the District of Columbia. The population then was 278,718. Cable cars were being replaced by electric cars and horse drawn vehicles were giving way to automobiles. Railroad tracks still lay on the Mall. The sites of the Lincoln and Jefferson Memorials were still a swamp land. William McKinley was President and Theodore Roosevelt was Vice-President. The District at that time had a veterinarian on the payrolls as there were 500 horses and mules in service.


The unfair and prejudiced assessment of the Dallas jury against you has caused a great concern to sweep over our entire congregation as well as the citizens of our city.

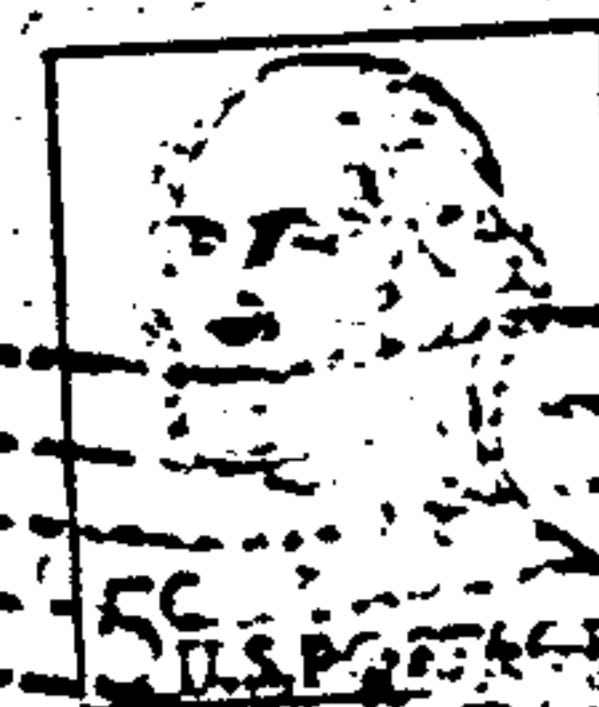
