APPRISED FULLY OF ALL DEVELOPMENTS.

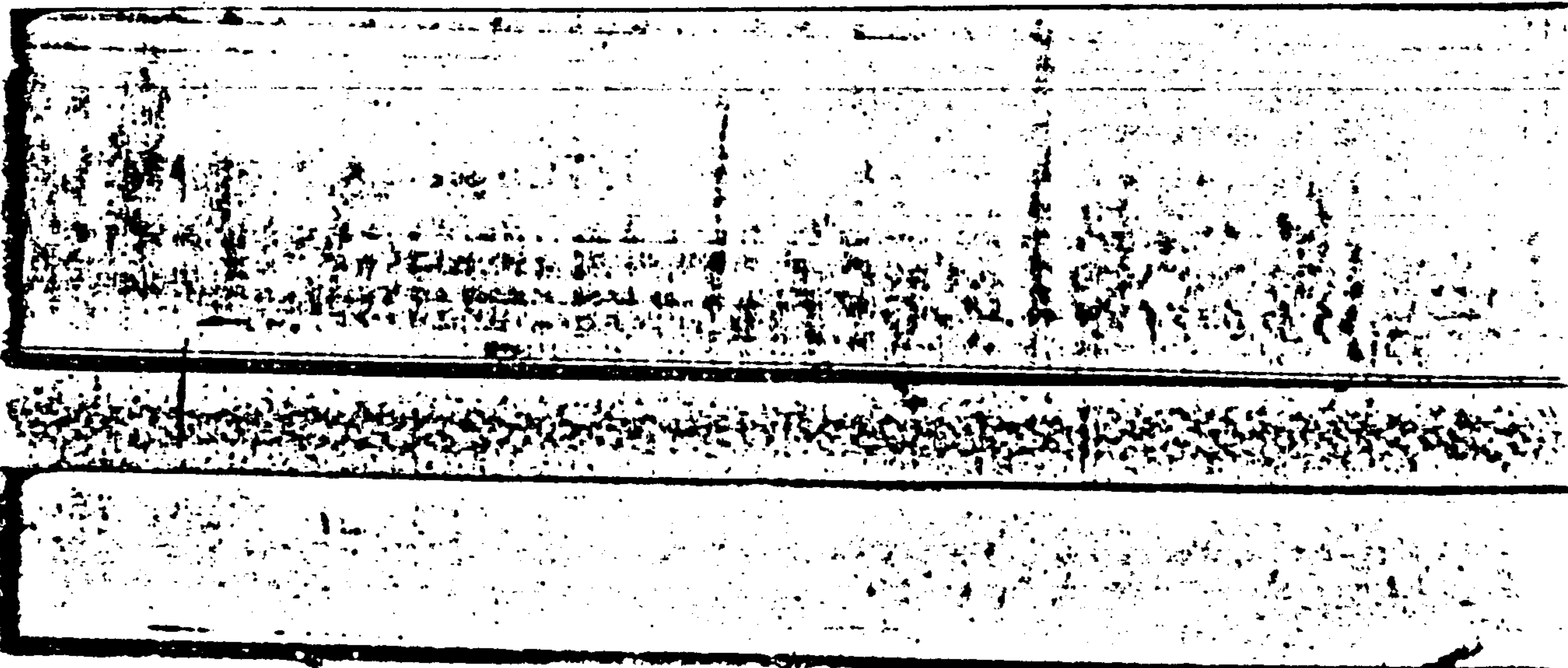

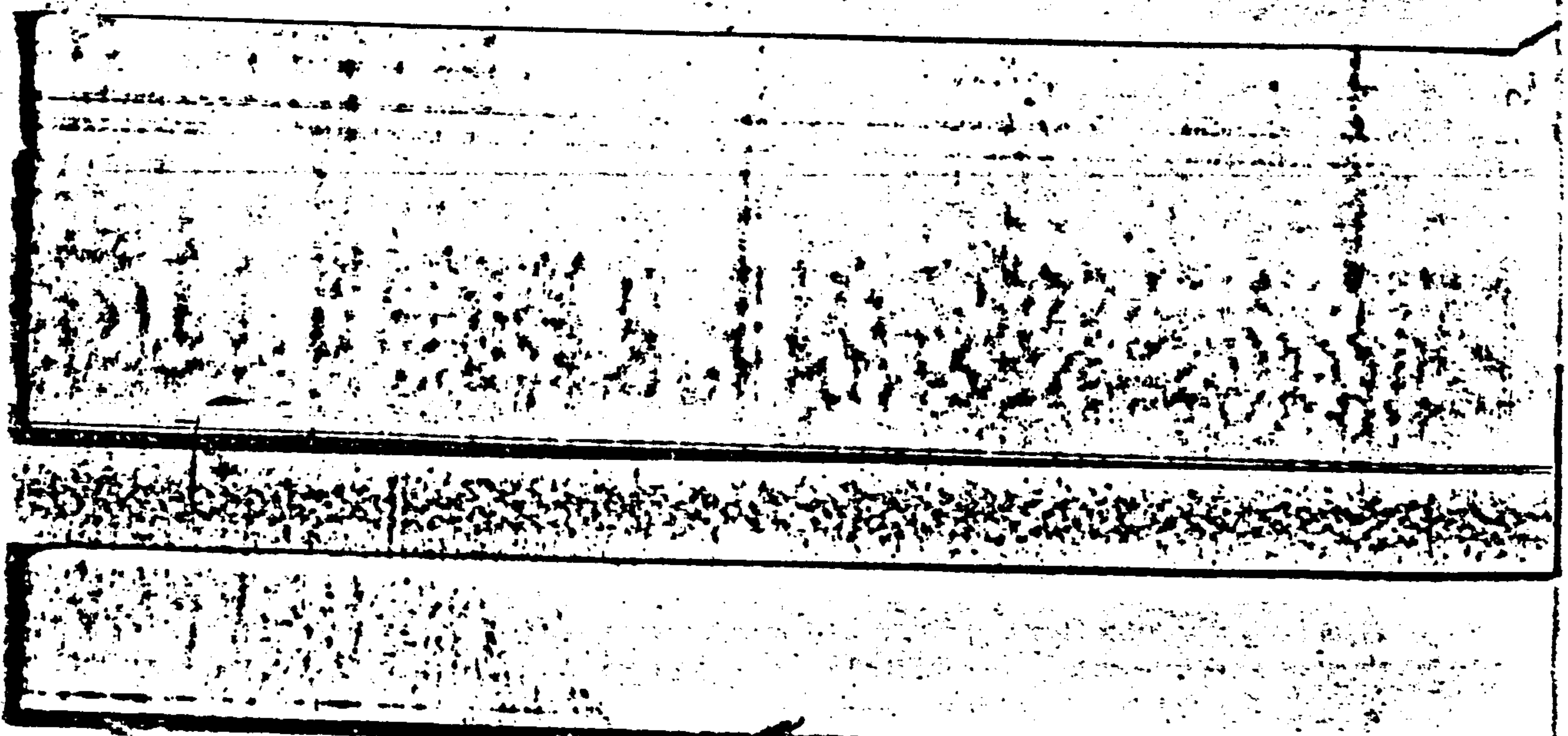

LEE HARVEY OSWALD HAS BEEN DEVELOPED AS THE PRINCIPAL SUSPECT IN THE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY. HE HAS BEEN FORMERLY CHARGED WITH THE PRESIDENT'S MURDER ALONG WITH THE MURDER OF DALLAS TEXAS PATROLMAN J. D. TIPPETT BY TEXAS STATE AUTHORITIES. IN VIEW OF DEVELOPMENTS ALL OFFICES SHOULD RESUME NORMAL CONTACTS WITH INFORMANTS AND OTHER SOURCES WITH RESPECT TO BOMBING SUSPECTS, HATE GROUP MEMBERS AND KNOWN RACIAL EXTREMISTS. DAILY TELETYPE SUMMARIES MAY BE DISCONTINUED. ALL INVESTIGATION BEARING DIRECTLY ON THE PRESIDENT'S ASSASSINATION SHOULD BE AFFORDED MOST EXPEDITIOUS HANDLING AND BUREAU AND DALLAS ADVISED. 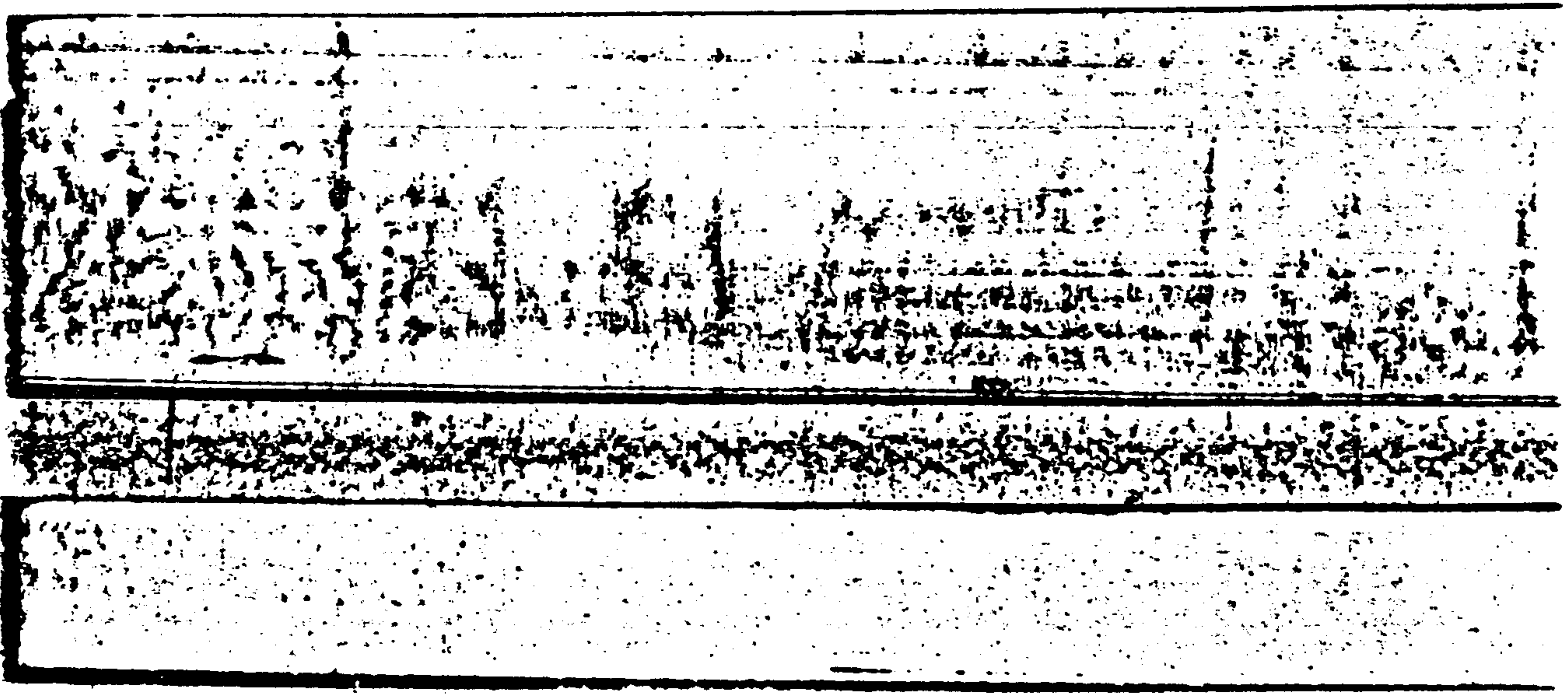

Why was President Kennedy killed in Texas Johnsons home state?" Another: "Story of President Kennedy's death is fake." Another states: "As a citizen I request a thorough investigation of the possibility of subversive activity on the part of Lyndon B. Johnson with regards to the assinsation recently occurred."

It is not believed these wires deserve any reply whatsoever and no time is being wasted in searching Bureau files for information concerning the identity of the senders.

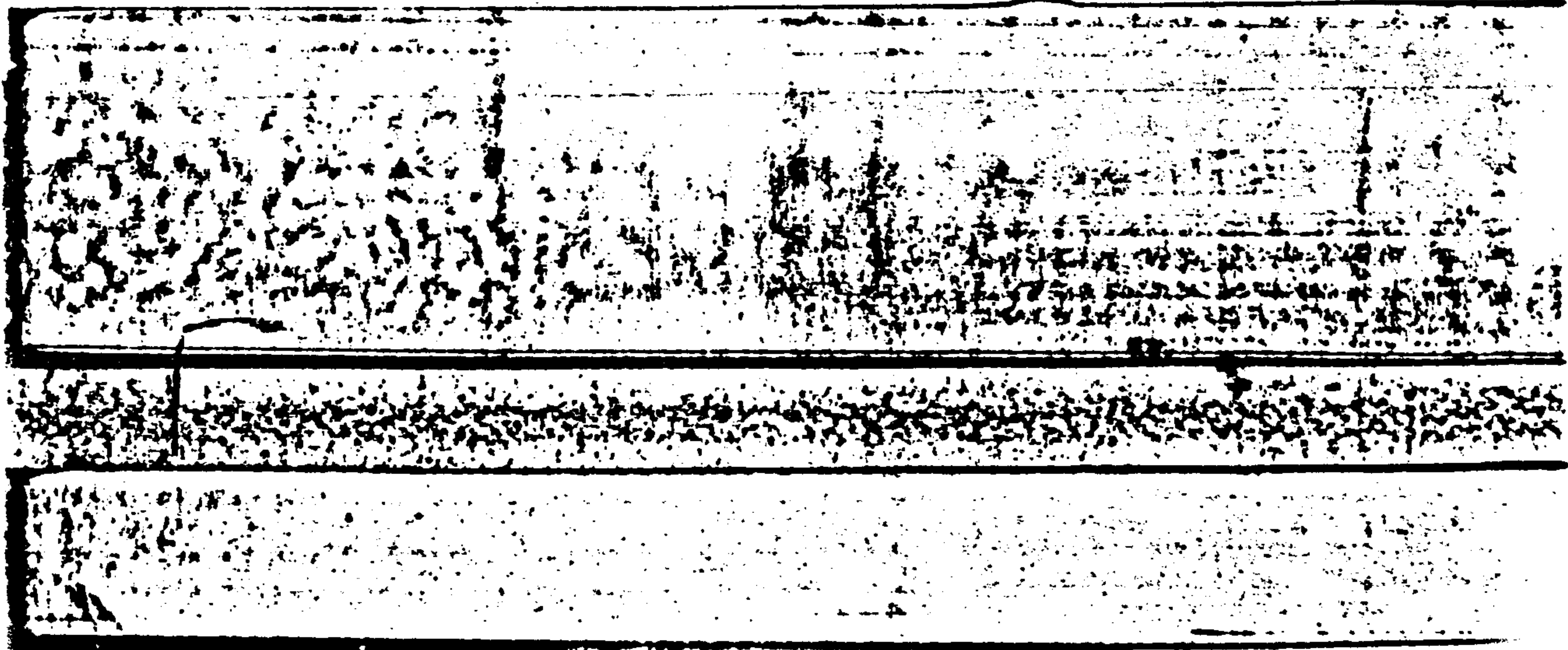

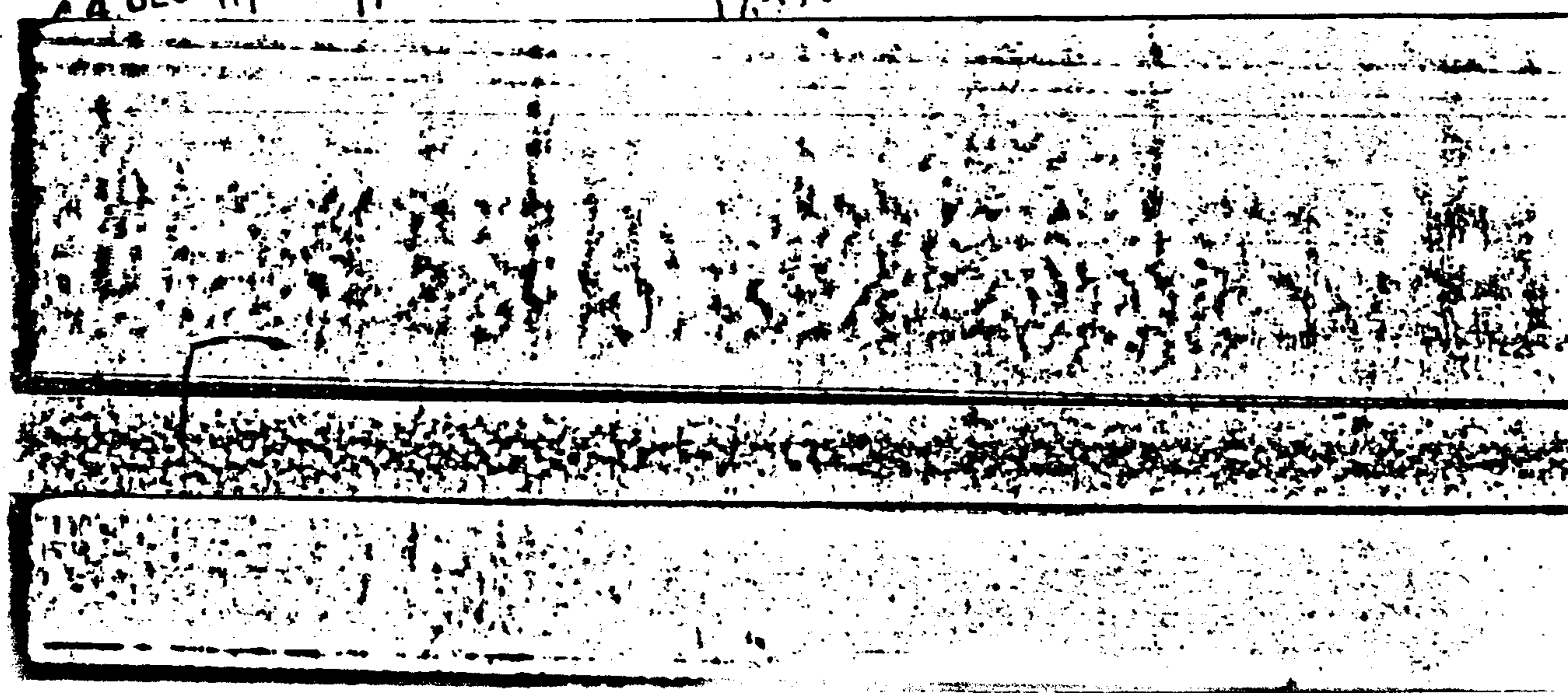

Dear Mrs. Marks:

At times of stress, individuals are quick to find fault. More often than not they speak without any knowledge of the facts. Unfortunately the telegram of November 22, 1963, from you and Mr. Marks indicates unfamiliarity with our jurisdiction.

At this time in the Nation's bereavement, I am disturbed by your implied accusation of negligence and feel it necessary to inform you that the protection of the President and his immediate family is the responsibility of the Secret Service of the United States Treasury Department and not the FBI. Secret Service Agents were with the President at the time he was assassinated, and they, as any reasonable person would realize, are particularly grieved over this tragedy and need support rather than criticism during this trying time.

There is being submitted herewith for examination by the FBI Laboratory the following items which were obtained from Captain WILL FRITZ of the Dallas Police Department, Dallas, Texas, on the authority of Chief of Police JESSE E. CURRY, NA, Dallas Police Department:

1. Live round rifle shell 6.5 millimeter, which was found in rifle, SN C 2766, which was believed to be the gun used in the above assassination.
2. Spent hulls of 6.5 millimeter shell believed to have been fired in rifle, SN C 2766, believed to have been the gun used in the above-captioned matter.
3. One blanket found at the scene where the rifle was located, which may have been the blanket used as a cover for carrying this rifle.
4. One shirt taken from suspect LEE HARVEY OSWALD.
5. Brown paper which was found at what was believed to be the point of firing of the fatal bullets used in the assassination. This paper possibly may have been used to carry above rifle to the scene of the building from which it was fired.

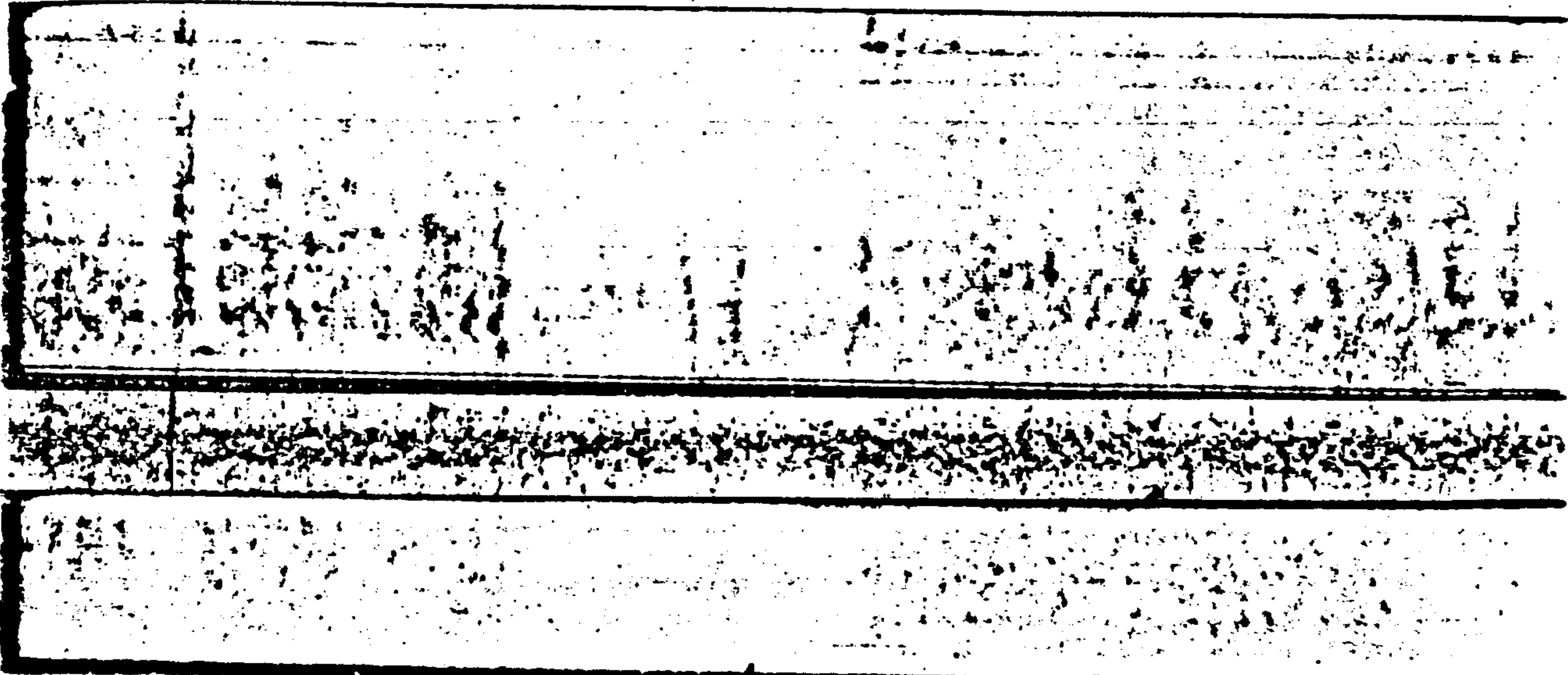

At 1:44 p.m., today, SAC Joseph Purvis, Norfolk, telephonically advised Supervisor J. W. Burns that immediately prior to his call, the Police Department at Newport News, Virginia, had received an anonymous telephone call from a male described as obviously Negro/who stated roughly, "We got the President; now we are going to get Senator Byrd."

SAC Purvis was instructed to confirm all pertinent information concerning this call by teletype.

ACTION:

At 1:48 p.m., Mr. D. Hanning, Duty Agent, Crime Records Division, was telephonically advised concerning this information. Mr. Hanning stated that the Crime Records Division would handle the transmittal of this information to Senator Byrd or his staff at the earliest possible time.

1 - Mr. DeLoach

SAC Purvis telephonically advised that the Newport News, Virginia, Police Department stated Walter Robinson was intoxicated at the time of his arrest, and stated that he did not know why he made the call except that Byrd "never did any thing for me." He did not represent himself as Minor Miller, however, he was located at Miller's address, and the police are confident that neither Miller nor anyone else at this address conspired with Robinson to make this call.
