SUBJECT: SALBY

1. The following information comes from a Soviet Intelligence defector whose bona fides have not been established.

2. Source reported that in July or August 1959 the KGB recruited a professor of literature from a university in Tennessee with the surname [REDACTED]. His KGB cryptonym is [REDACTED]. According to Source, [REDACTED] had progressive (s) views politically and was well disposed towards the USSR. He was recruited on the grounds of homosexuality: compromising photographs of him were taken by the KGB in Moscow and he was later confronted with these photographs in Minsk and was so shocked that he agreed to do anything. (Source also reported Uzhgorod as the place of recruitment.) He was, according to Source, travelling through the USSR in the company of another homosexual, whom Source did not identify.

3. Source described [REDACTED] as being dark featured, possibly part Negro, and about 40 years old. He was considered to be of little value to the KGB and contact with him was eventually dropped.

4. It is requested that no dissemination of this material be made outside your Bureau without prior consultation with this Agency.

1. The following information comes from a Soviet Intelligence defector whose bona fides has not been established.

2. Cryptonym [redacted] a former State Department official. At one time press attache in the American Embassy in Moscow. He had worked with [redacted] (in(s) Germany in 1949 and 1950, and is now with the [redacted] (s). Subject believes that he was purged several years ago when the State Department cleaned out homosexuals and [redacted] (s) is one of those suspect. [redacted] was recruited in 1961 and the case was handed over to the First Chief Directorate, but they have not as yet started to work with him.

3. It is requested that no dissemination of this material be made outside your Bureau without prior consultation with this Agency.

SUBJECT: Recruitment of [REDACTED] (S)

1. Reference is made to our CSC [REDACTED] dated 5 February 1964.

2. According to Source, one [REDACTED] (S) and former member of the United States Embassy staff in Moscow, arrived in Moscow in 1961 as a tourist, staying in the USSR for about 20 days. The KGB decided to run a blackmail operation against him in which he was accused of rape. The KGB, according to Source, were able to mount the operation easily by taking advantage of a situation wherein [REDACTED] (S) was completely drunk. The KGB, using photography, arranged an apparently compromising situation. (u)

3. KGB officers were directed to go to [REDACTED] (S) and talk to him, but not to recruit him. Accusations were made against him, and he was told that since he no longer had diplomatic immunity, he was subject to imprisonment. One of the KGB officers made an appointment with [REDACTED] (S) for the following day, promising to see what could be done to eliminate the charges. He was requested to write some statements of confession, and a request for clemency, etc.

4. Source reported that in the meantime, [REDACTED] (S) left a letter at the American Embassy to his mother in [REDACTED] (S) describing what trouble he was in, which was evidently opened by the Embassy; a cable was subsequently sent by Minister-Counselor [REDACTED] (S) which was intercepted by the KGB) to the effect that the man was approached by Soviet intelligence and that pressure was being put on him.

5. According to Source, the KGB again approached [redacted] and confronted him with the same accusations, and (s) said that nothing would happen to him and that the whole thing could be quashed. Source said that [redacted] did not turn the KGB down completely, and actually gave them an agreement and signed an obligation to work for them.

6. Source reported that [redacted] (s) when he returned to the United States, was again approached by the KGB and reminded of what had happened to him in Moscow. He agreed to cooperate with them, and thereafter had meetings with the KGB resident in New York. (As far as can be determined on the basis of information received to date, the meetings in New York occurred during 1962.)

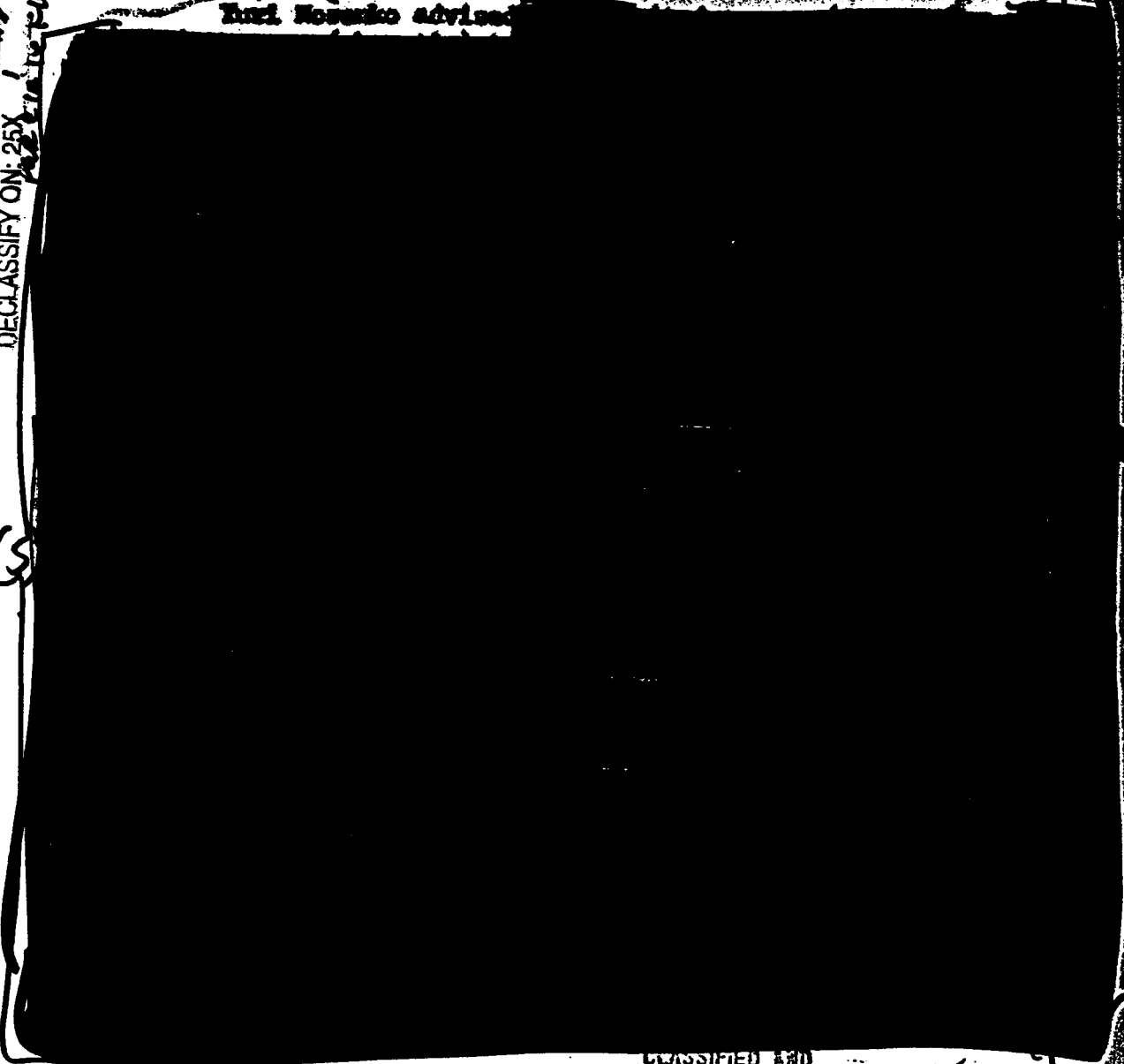
