Source was shown photographs of NATHAN GREGORY SILVERMASTER and wife HELEN WITTE SILVERMATER. He could not identify either picture and said only that the surname was familiar. Upon being furnished a slight background concerning SILVERMASTER he said he recalled this name and remembered in 1963 the First Directorate had learned that SILVERWASTER was visiting Russia along about the end of his visit. As a result, there was a disagreement between the First Directorate and the Seventh Department of the Second Directorate because the latter had not notified the Foreign Intelligence Directorate despite the fact that organization had placed no flash notice with the Seventh Department. Source advised he knew no details about SILVERMASTER but had heard from some of the boys, identity not recalled, in the First Directorate that he was an old and valued agent who had received a Soviet award which he believed to be the Order of the Red Banner.

Photographs of and ISIDORE "GIBEY" NEEDLEMAN were shown to source who could identify neither.

Picture of was shown to NOSENKO who could not identify byd photo but stated he had heard the name and recalled he had seen articles in Moscow on economic topics.
