On 3/23/64, THE DIRECTOR INQUIRED, IN CONNECTION  
with a report of a possible assassination attempt, whose identity has  
not yet been established, was interviewed by the [redacted]

During the course of the interview, photographs  
of subject and his wife, [redacted], were  
shown to subject. He could not identify either picture and  
stated only that the person was familiar.

Subject being furnished a slight background concerning  
the fact source said he recalled this name and remembered  
the First Directorate had learned that subject was  
traveling Mexico, along about the end of subject's visit. As  
a result, there was a disagreement between the First Directorate  
and the Second Directorate of the Second Directorate, [redacted]  
[redacted] did not recalled the Foreign Intelligence Director  
[redacted] the fact that organization had placed in their  
files with the Second Directorate. Source said he knew no  
other name subject, but had heard from some of the [redacted]

1. Attached herewith are copies of the State Department telegrams from the Embassy in Moscow describing visits by Subject's wife and mother to the Embassy. As you are aware, no Soviet citizen can enter the Embassy without the KGB's permission since all Soviet guards on the Embassy detail are under direct KGB control.
2. These visits by the immediate relatives of an intelligence defector represent the first time to our knowledge that this has ever occurred. In addition, the request to meet with Subject in this country is also without precedent in the case of an intelligence defector.
3. We have told Subject of the events described in the telegrams from Moscow and he has indicated considerable interest in the contents of the letters and has said that he does not want to respond to the request for a meeting with his wife and mother until after he has seen the letters.

WIFE AND MOTHER SOVIET DEFECTOR NOSENKO CAME TO EMBASSY TODAY AND ASKED TO SEE AMBASSADOR. WERE REFERRED TO CONSULAR OFFICER. TOLD CONSULAR OFFICER THEY WOULD SPEAK ONLY WITH AMBASSADOR AND DEMANDED AMBASSADOR RECEIVE THEM OR EXPLAIN WHY HE WOULD NOT DO SO. PREPARED WAIT ALL DAY IF NECESSARY.
