



























You are instructed to interview regarding his travels overseas, and particularly his travels behind the Iron Curtain. You should determine if he has ever been approached for any intelligence purposes and endeaver to elicit information concerning his alleged clandestine entries into Czecheslovakia during the period 1949-1951.

You should particularly endeavor to obtain from him details concerning information previously obtained from the Department of State indicating subject clandestinely entered Czechoslovakia in 1948, and again in the Summer of 1949, while attempting to enter Czechoslovakia, was arrested by the Germans and subsequently released.

If subject proves cooperative during this interview and it appears desirable, Boston is authorized to advise him we have received information from a source of unknown reliability that Czech intelligence has an interest in him and has through the Czech Government arranged to have him arrested in the event he visits the Soviet Union and then deported to Czechoelevakia. If this information is furnished to the subject, it should be impressed uponkhim that itsis being given to him for his confidential information and that we are unable to elaborate further upon it, and he should be requested that this advice be kept by him in strict confidence.
