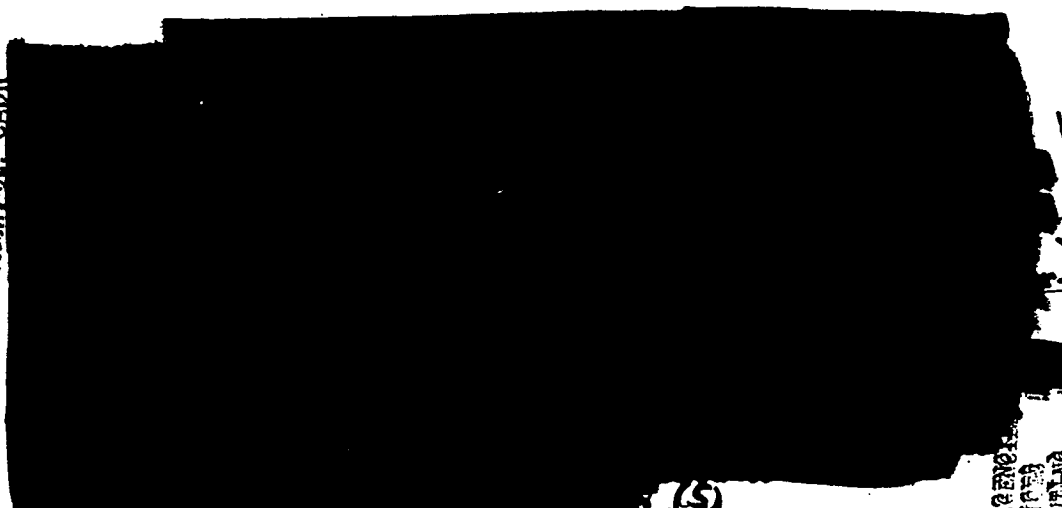

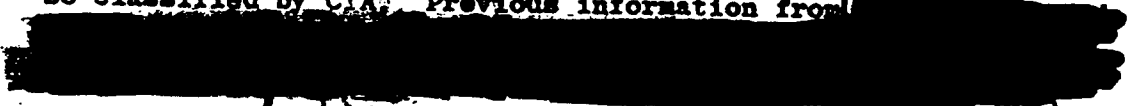

NEEDLEMAN is a practicing attorney in New York City. He is a little over 61 years old and was born in Kamenetz, Podolsk, Russia. He is a naturalized American citizen. He is 5' 2" tall and has a heavy build. His eyes are hazel and his hair is turning entirely gray. NEEDLEMAN is a victim of infantile paralysis and his left leg is useless. He wears braces, uses a cane, and advances with his right leg, dragging the other one behind. During the war and through the 1940's he was employed by the Amtorg Trading Corporation as General Counsel, and he continues to represent this organization from time to time. His principal contacts at Amtorg have been (u) (b)(3) (now in the Soviet Union) and (u) (b)(3)

NEEDLEMAN was invited to visit the Soviet Union in June, 1963, and was there with his wife till the latter part of September, 1963. He had suffered a heart attack in January, 1963, and was afforded medical examinations in Moscow, as well as treatment and a rest cure (u) (b)(3)
