CIA has requested that no dissemination of this information be made outside this Bureau without prior consultation with CIA. (u) (S)

For information of WFO, CIA previously furnished a summary of Nosenko's remarks concerning [redacted] which was furnished to New York. (u) (S)

New York should carefully review the enclosed and handle in accordance with instructions set forth in Bulet 3-5-64. Although CIA has requested that information from Nosenko not be disseminated without prior consultation, New York should submit the results of its efforts in a letterhead memorandum so CIA can have the benefits of your efforts. Include information set forth in your airtel 3-11-64. Upon receipt of your LHM, the Bureau can then consider requesting CIA concurrence if it is deemed advisable to further disseminate this information. (u) (S)
