BACKGROUND:

CIA advised that in questioning Sammy it learned that the [redacted] CIA (S)

Inasmuch as the Legat, [redacted] has his office in the American Embassy this information was sent to him by cable 3-16-64 to alert him to the situation. (S)

Since CIA requested that no dissemination be made of this information outside the Bureau without consultation with CIA no dissemination has been made. It is believed this information should be given to Department of State in order that it can take appropriate action to safeguard its information. (S)

San Diego should review files in its office for any logical suspects for the individuals mentioned by Sammy. Discreet inquiry among sources in the oil pipe line business or similar type business should be made in an attempt to identify any individuals employed in that field who traveled to Russia in the Fall of 1962 or the early part of 1963. For the information of San Diego, Sammy is the code name used for Yuri Nosenko, former KGB officer who defected in Geneva, Switzerland in 1964. In the event any information from him is reported, his identity should be concealed with a T symbol. (S)(u)

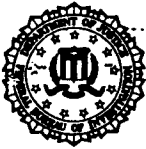

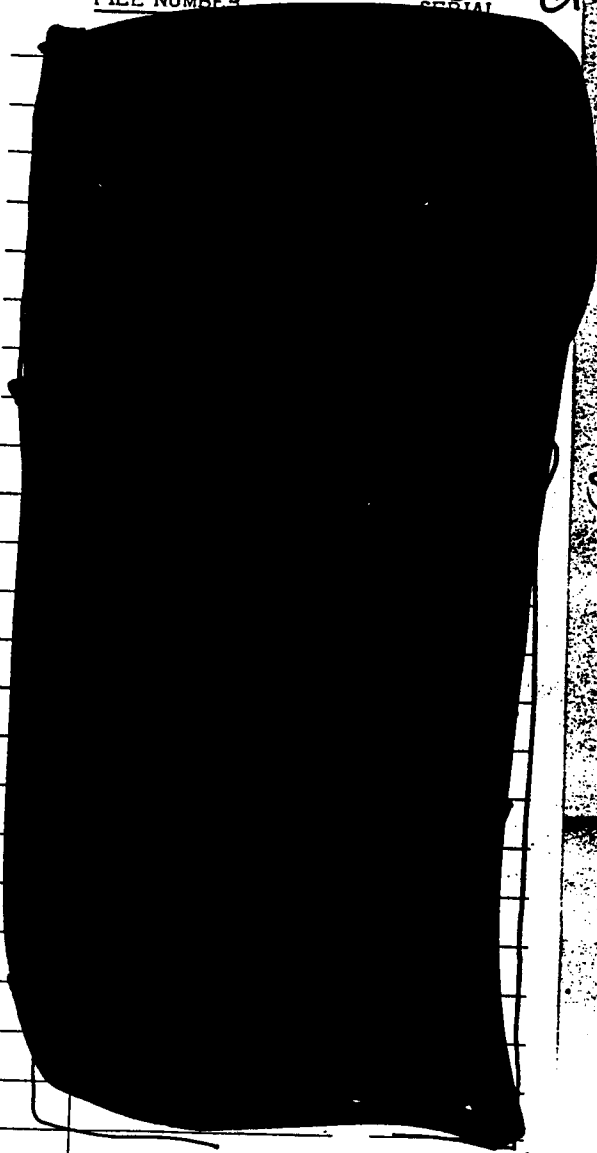
