
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



While originally it was contemplated we would only be able to interview Nosenko on four occasions prior to his taking a brief vacation, we were able to arrange with CIA to interview Nosenko daily during the period from 3-3 through 3-6. Considerable additional information has been obtained and we are pressing all angles vigorously.	W)
Current plans are for CIA to permit Nosenko (in accordance with his request) to take a two to three-week vacation starting next week. On his return to Washington arrangements will be made for additional interviews to see that we obtain all pertinent information and resolve investigation instituted from his information as rapidly as possible.

5. Regarding paragraph four of your memorandum, this Agency has provided your Bureau with all of the information obtained from SAMMY. In addition, there has just been completed a detailed review of all of the information received from SAMMY to date which bears on his bona fides. This review together

combined into a single report which will shortly be made available to your Bureau only.

6. It is requested that your Bureau make available to this Agency the results of your recent interviews with SAMMY. It will be recalled that this was agreed to by representatives of your Bureau in the meeting of 13 February.

7. This Agency requests that a decision on the dissemination of the information referred to in your memorandum be delayed until after your Bureau has had an opportunity to review the report mentioned above. As the report will demonstrate this is not an ordinary case and it would be impossible to convey to the community at large the impact the SAMMY case as well as and other cases may have on the current and past operations of this Agency and your Bureau.
